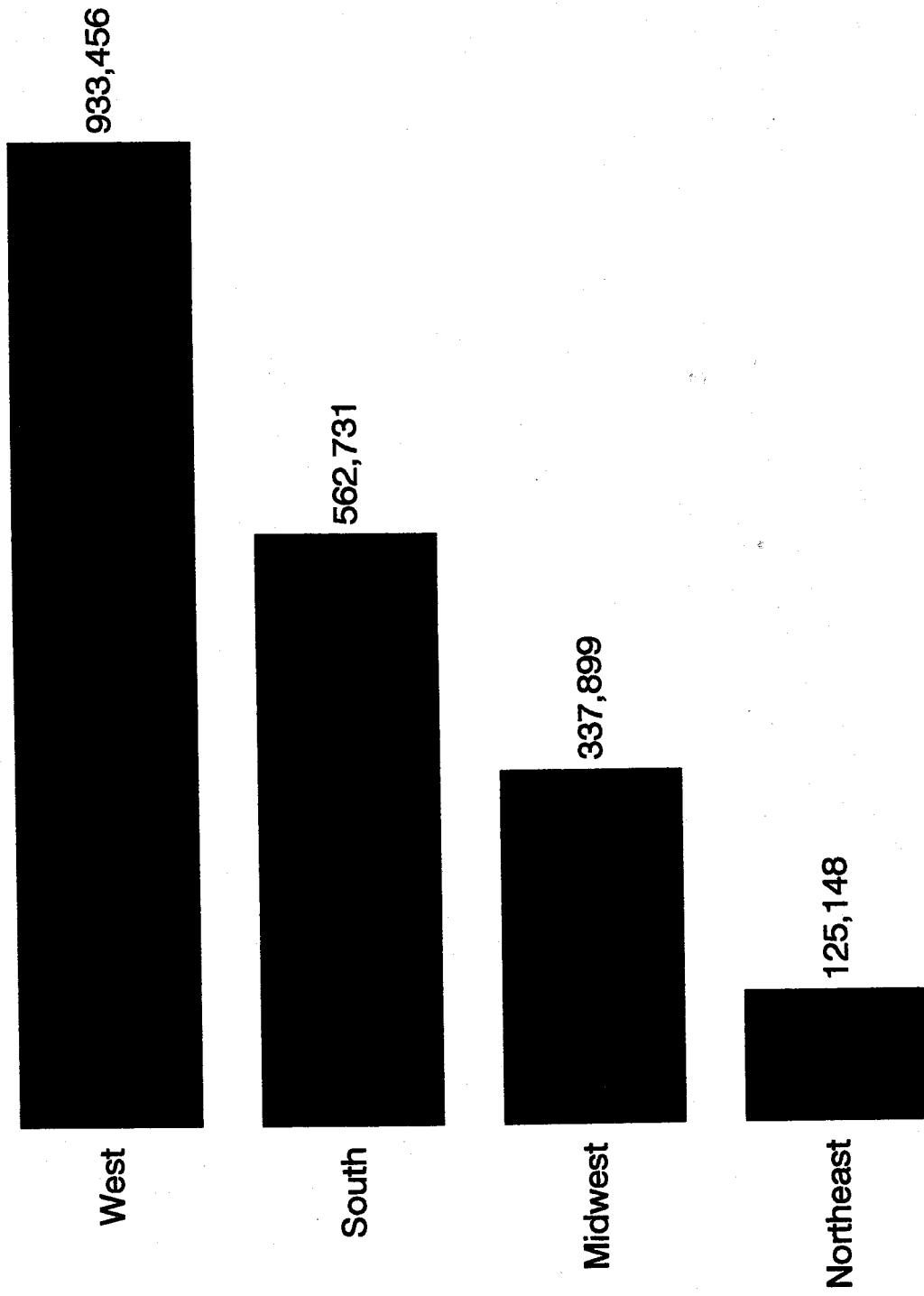

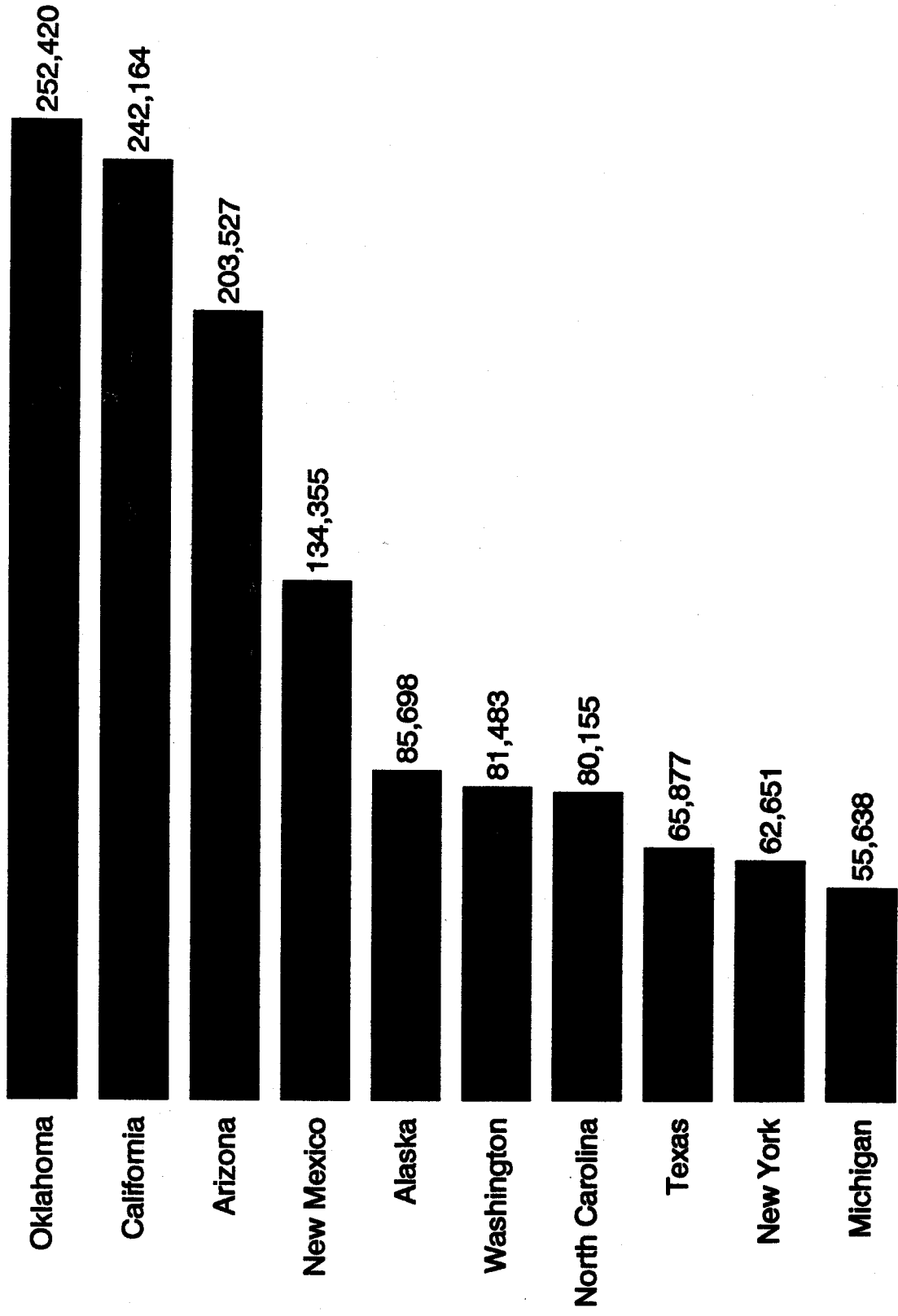

American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut Population by Region: 1990

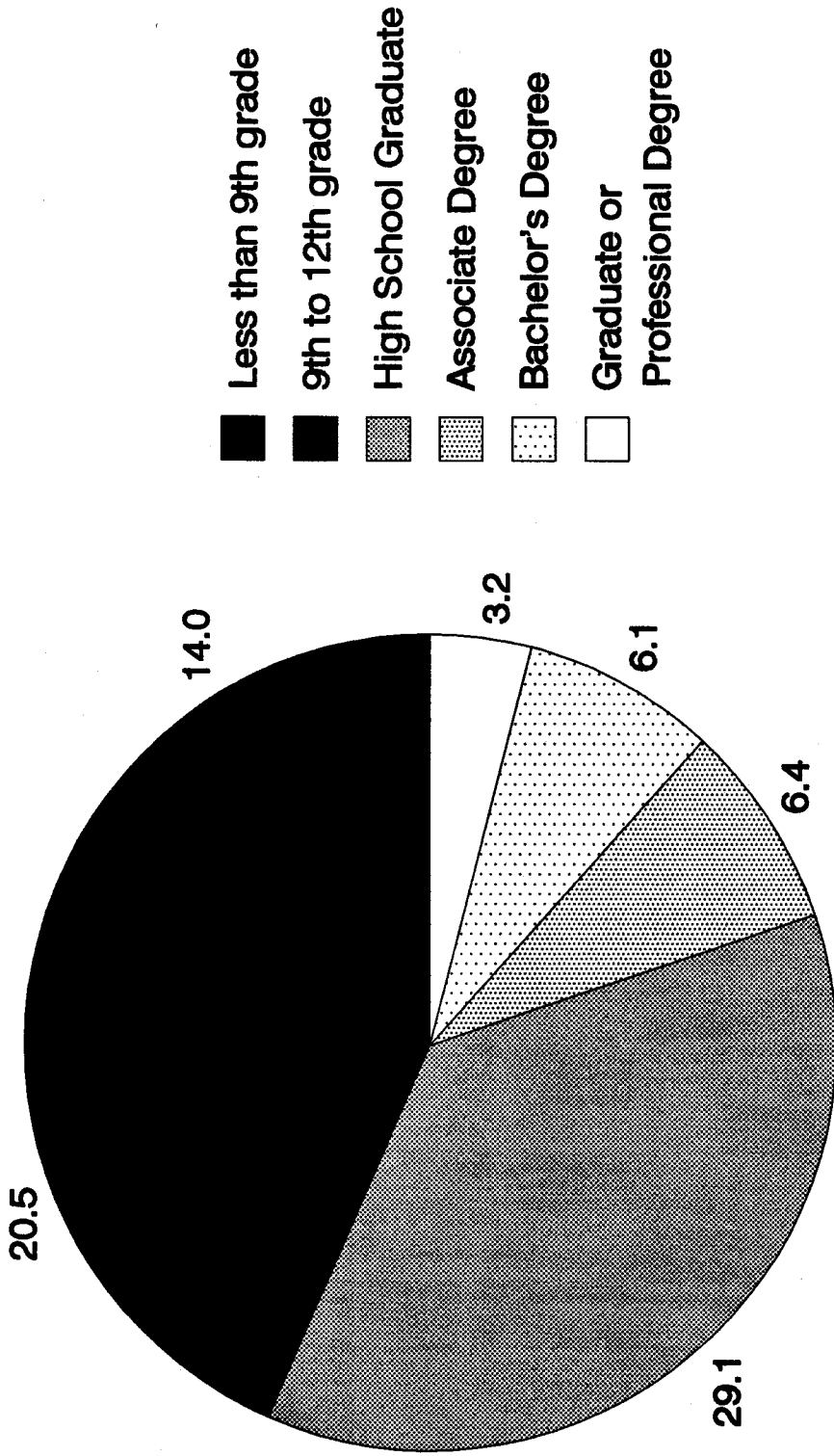


Ten States With the Largest American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut Population: 1990



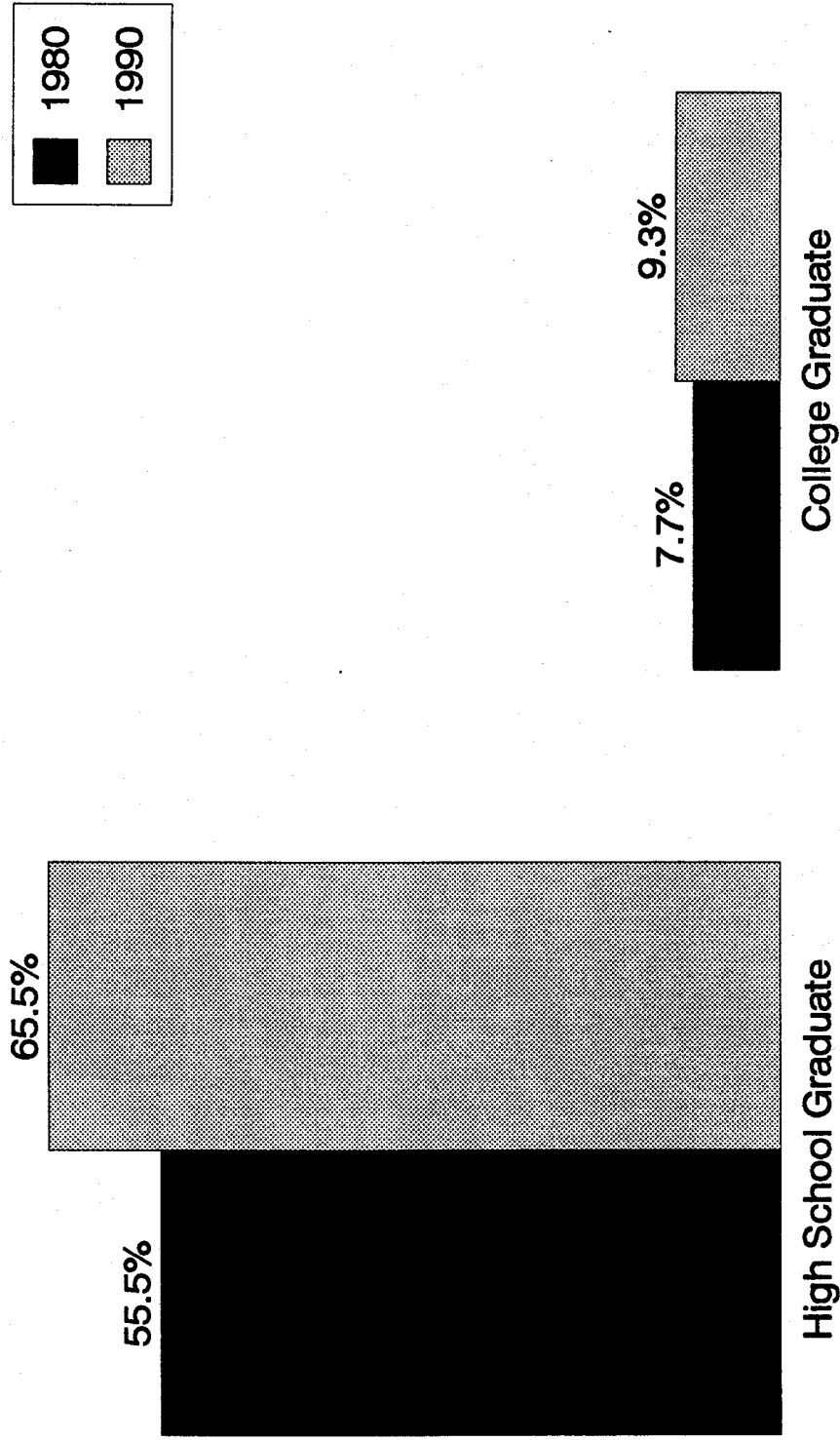
Educational Attainment of American Indians, Eskimos, and Aleuts in the United States: 1990

(In percent)



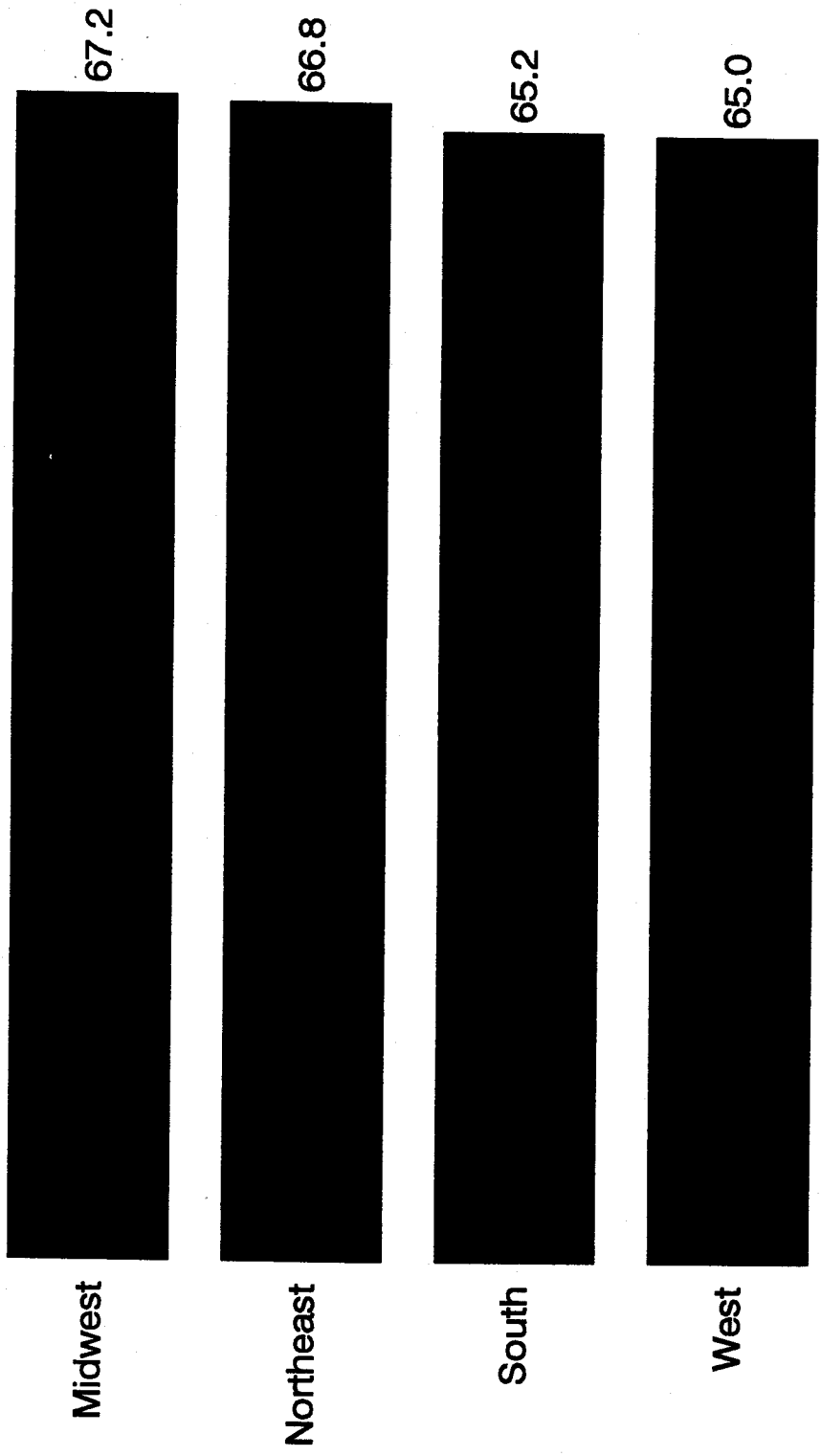

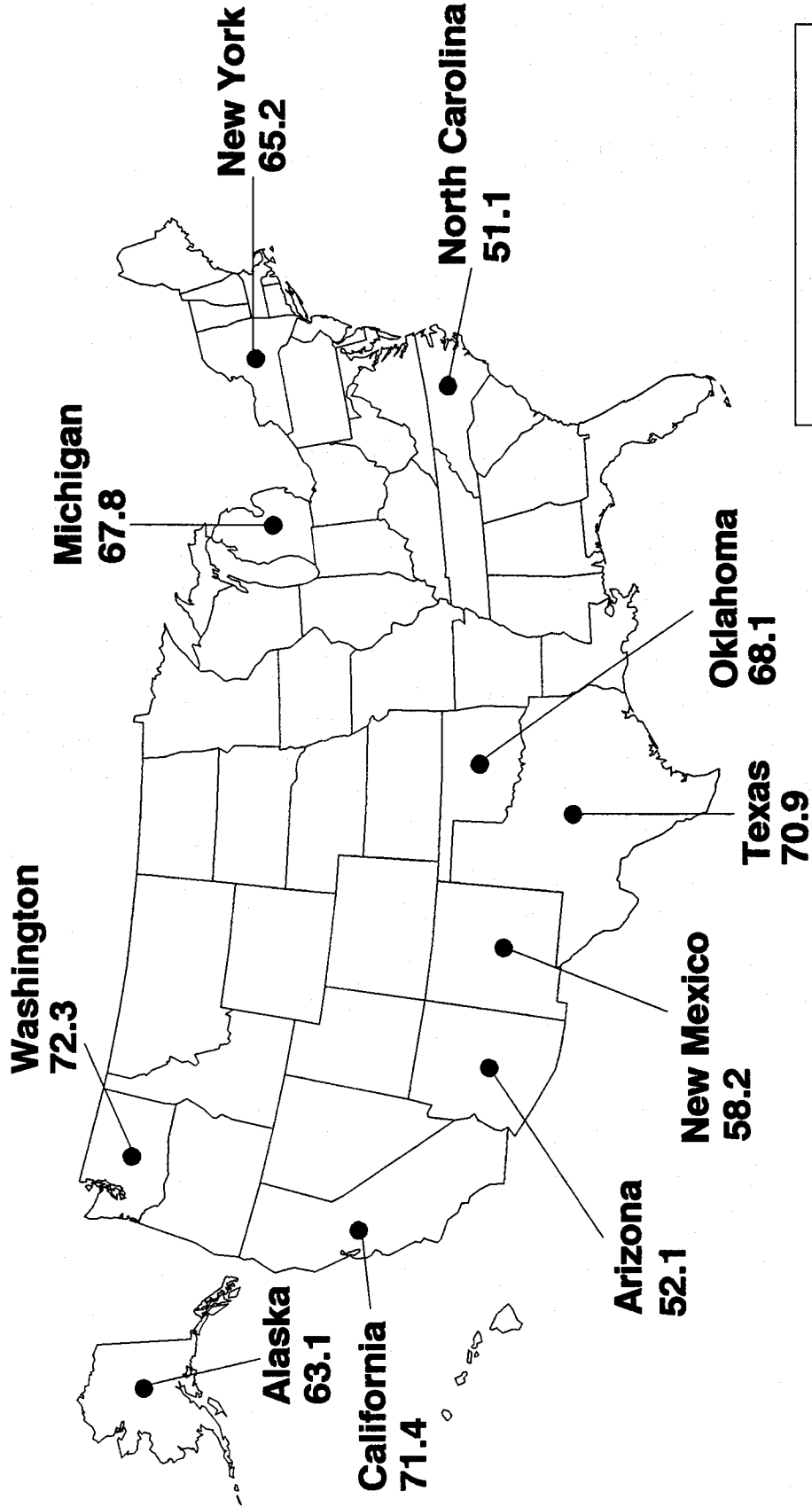
Percent of American Indian, Eskimo and Aleut High School Graduates by Region: 1990

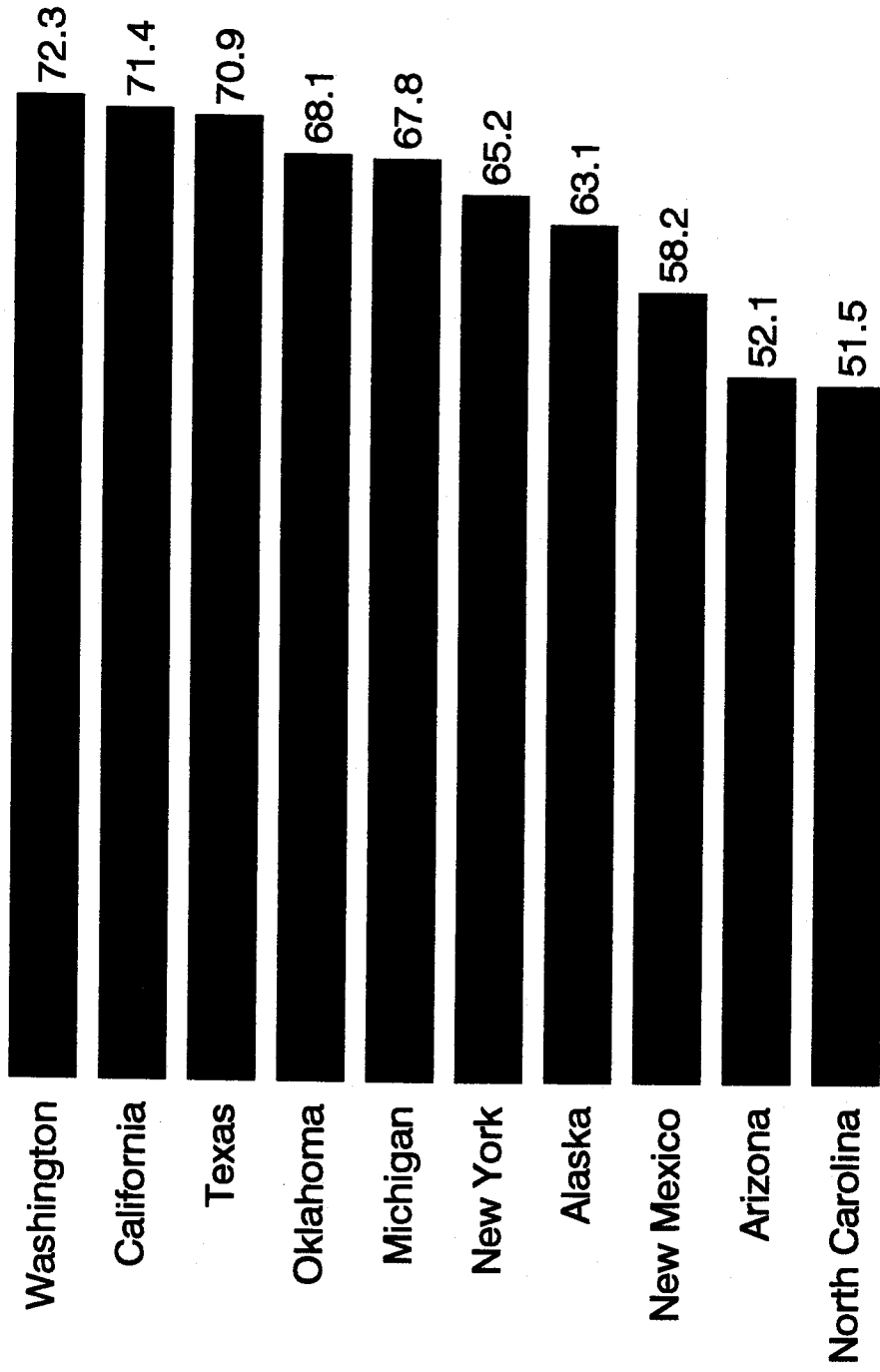

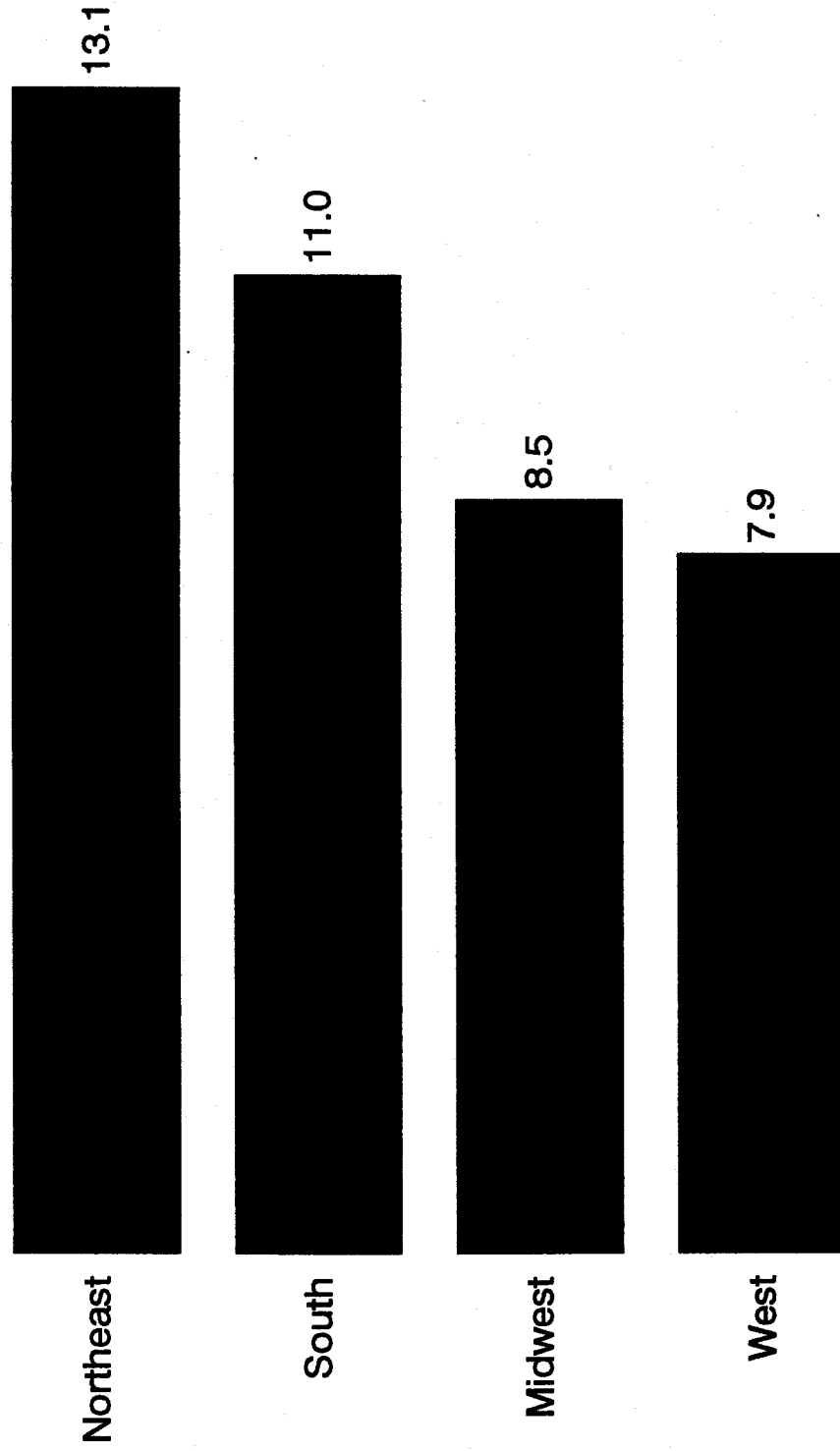
Percent of American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut High School Graduates: 1990

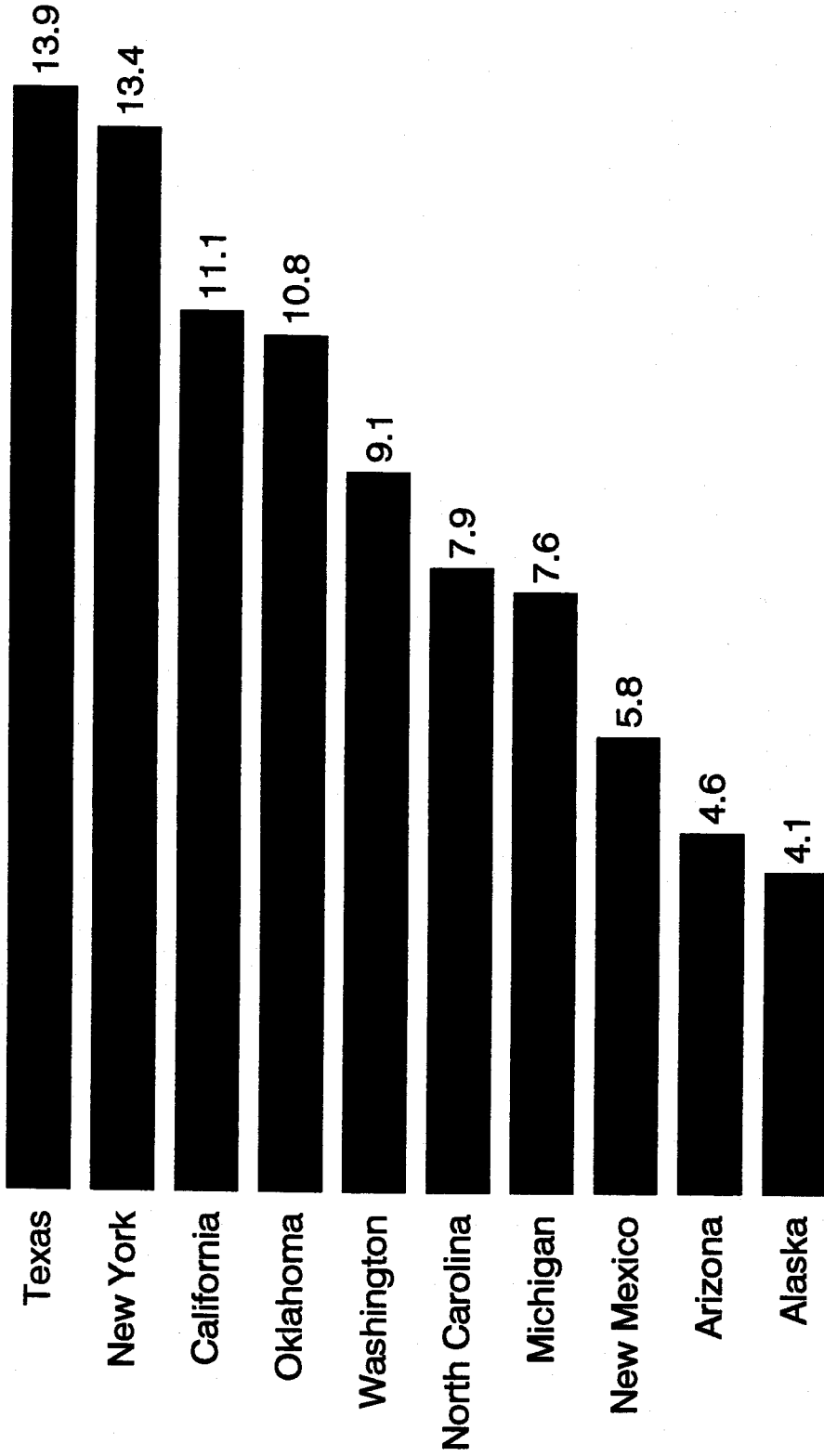
Percent of American Indians, Eskimos, and Aleuts With a Bachelor's Degree or Higher: 1990

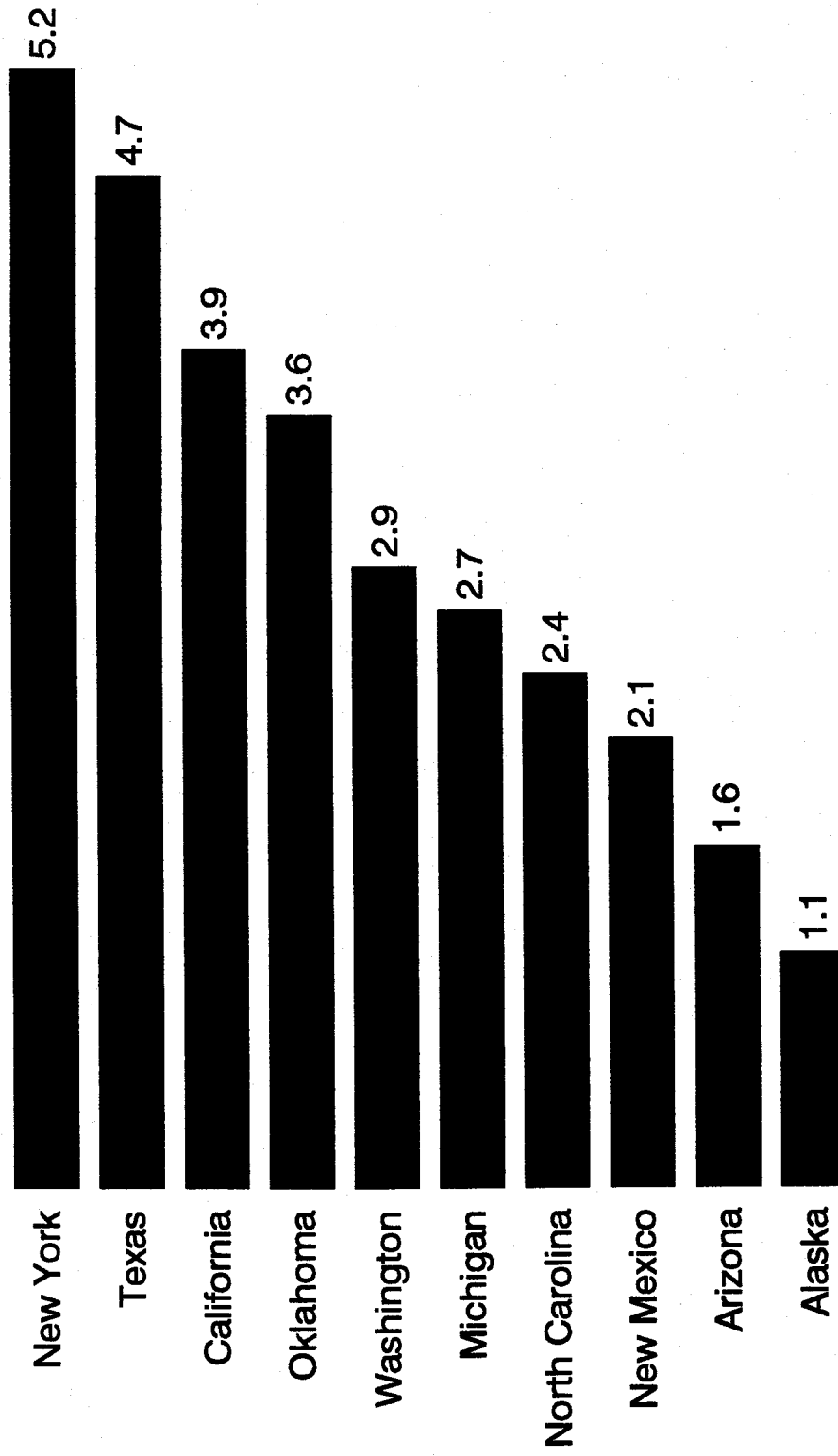
Percent of American Indians, Eskimos, and Aleuts With a Bachelor's Degree or Higher: 1990

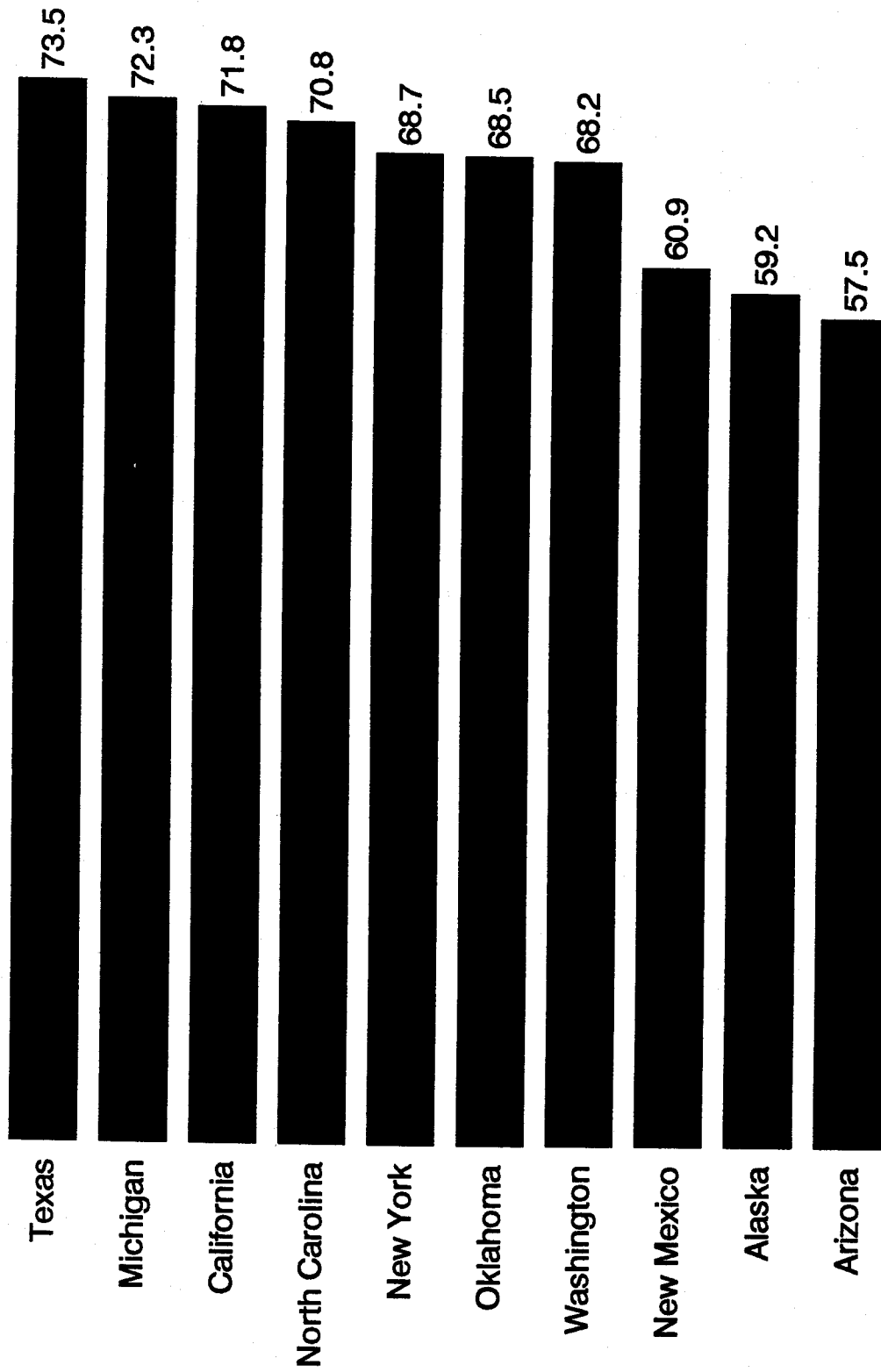
Percent of American Indians, Eskimos, and Aleuts With a Graduate or Professional Degree: 1990

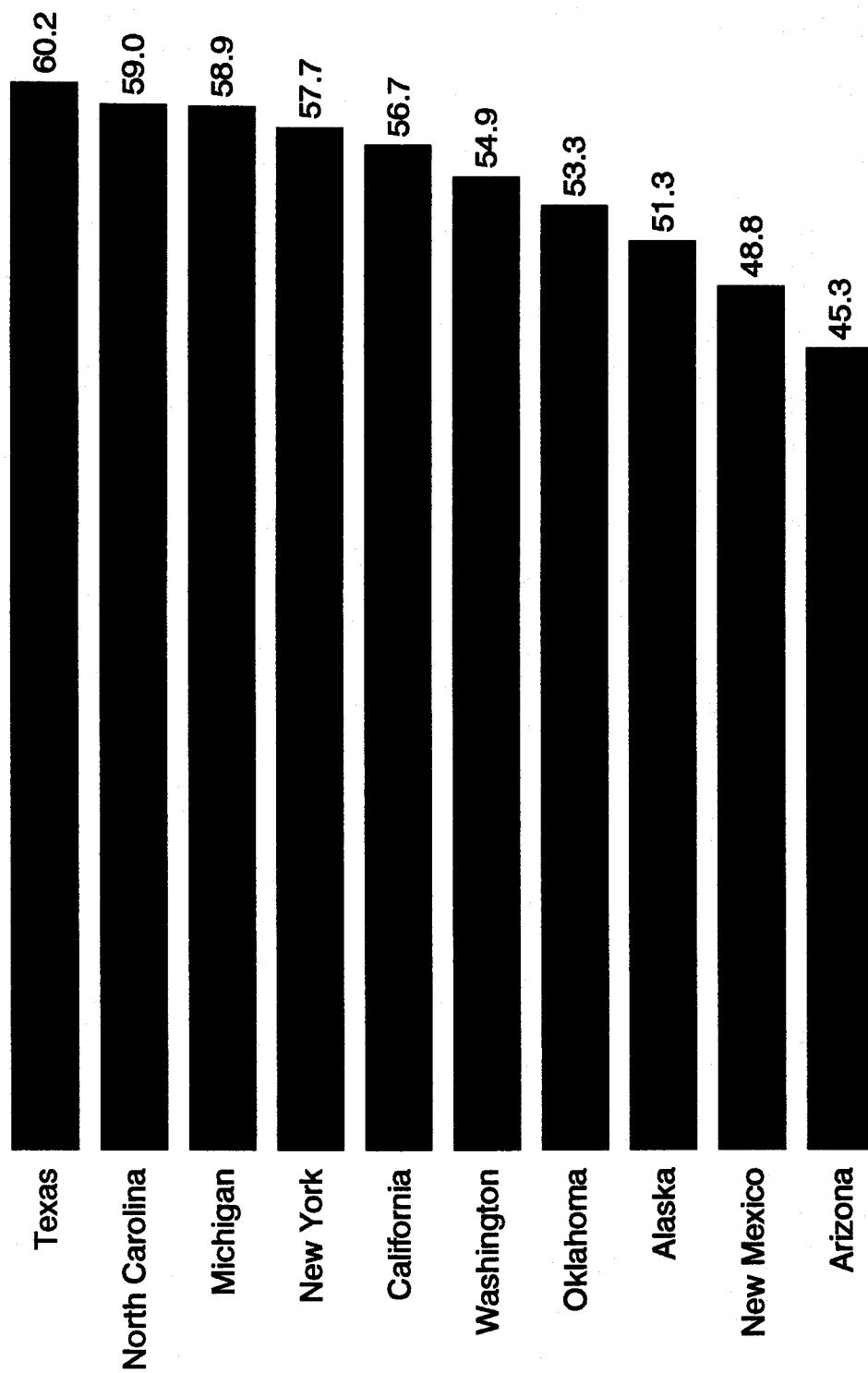
Percent of American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut Males in the Civilian Labor Force: 1990

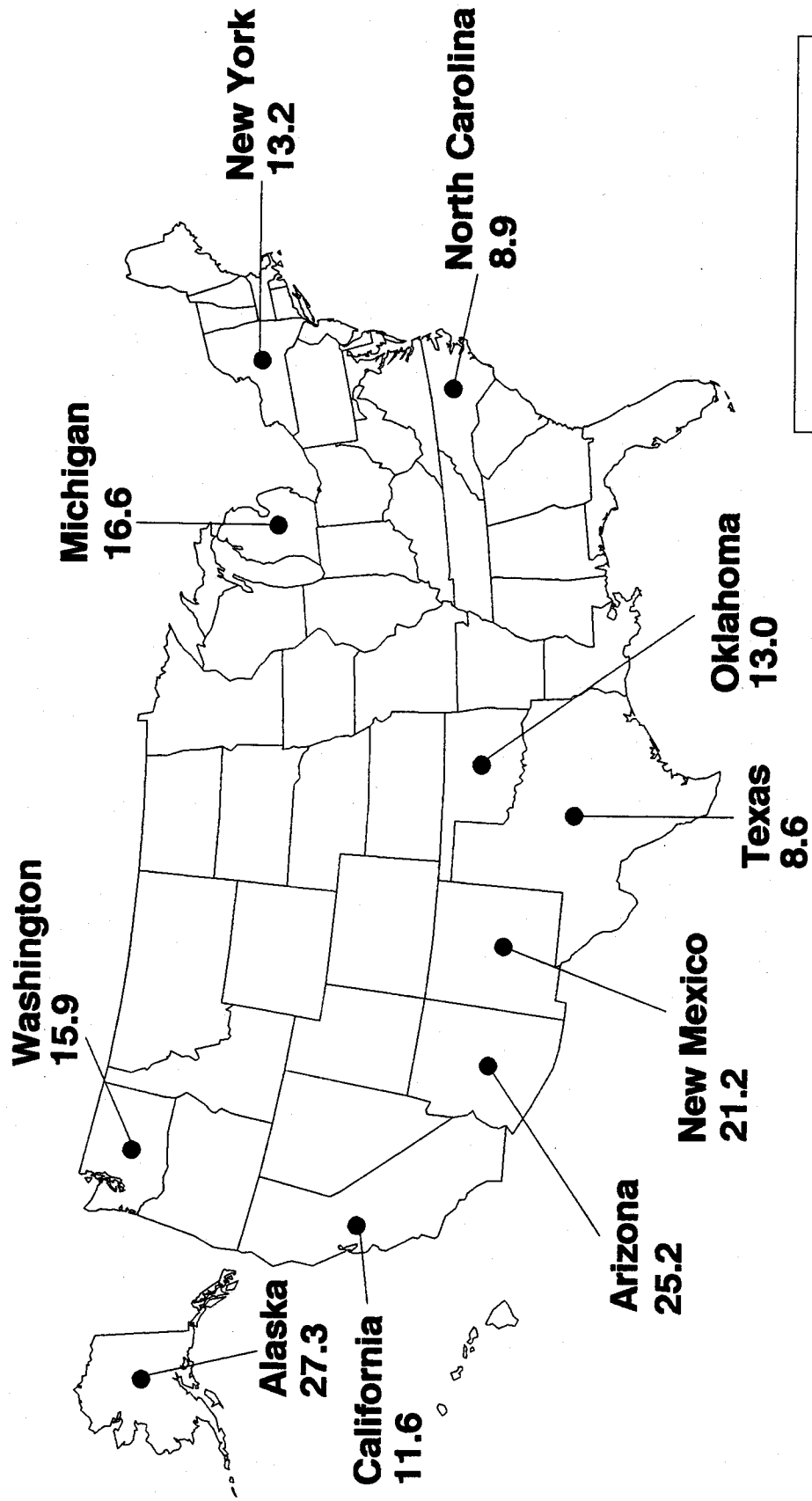
Percent of American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut Females in the Civilian Labor Force: 1990

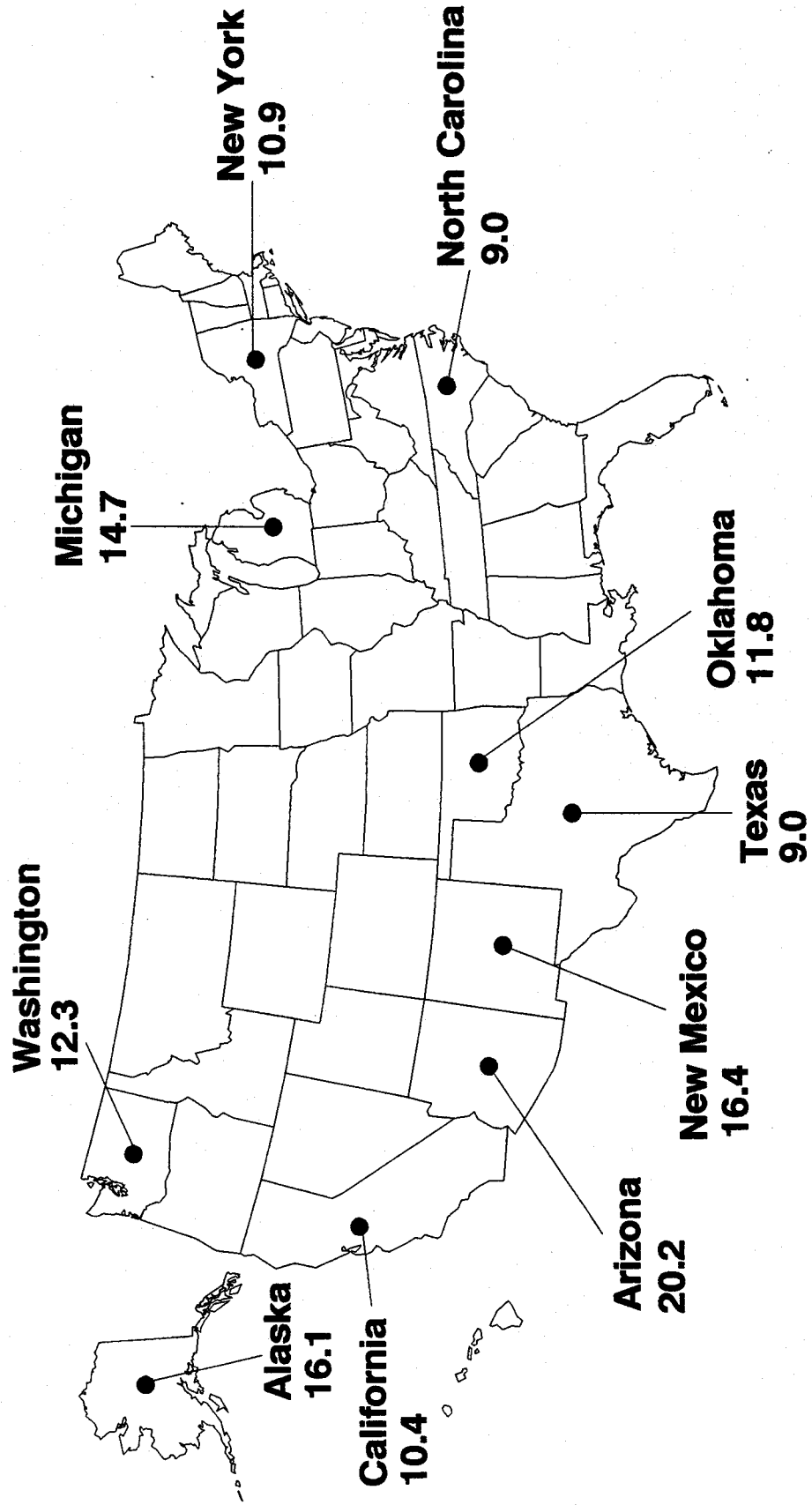
Percent of Unemployed American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut Males: 1990

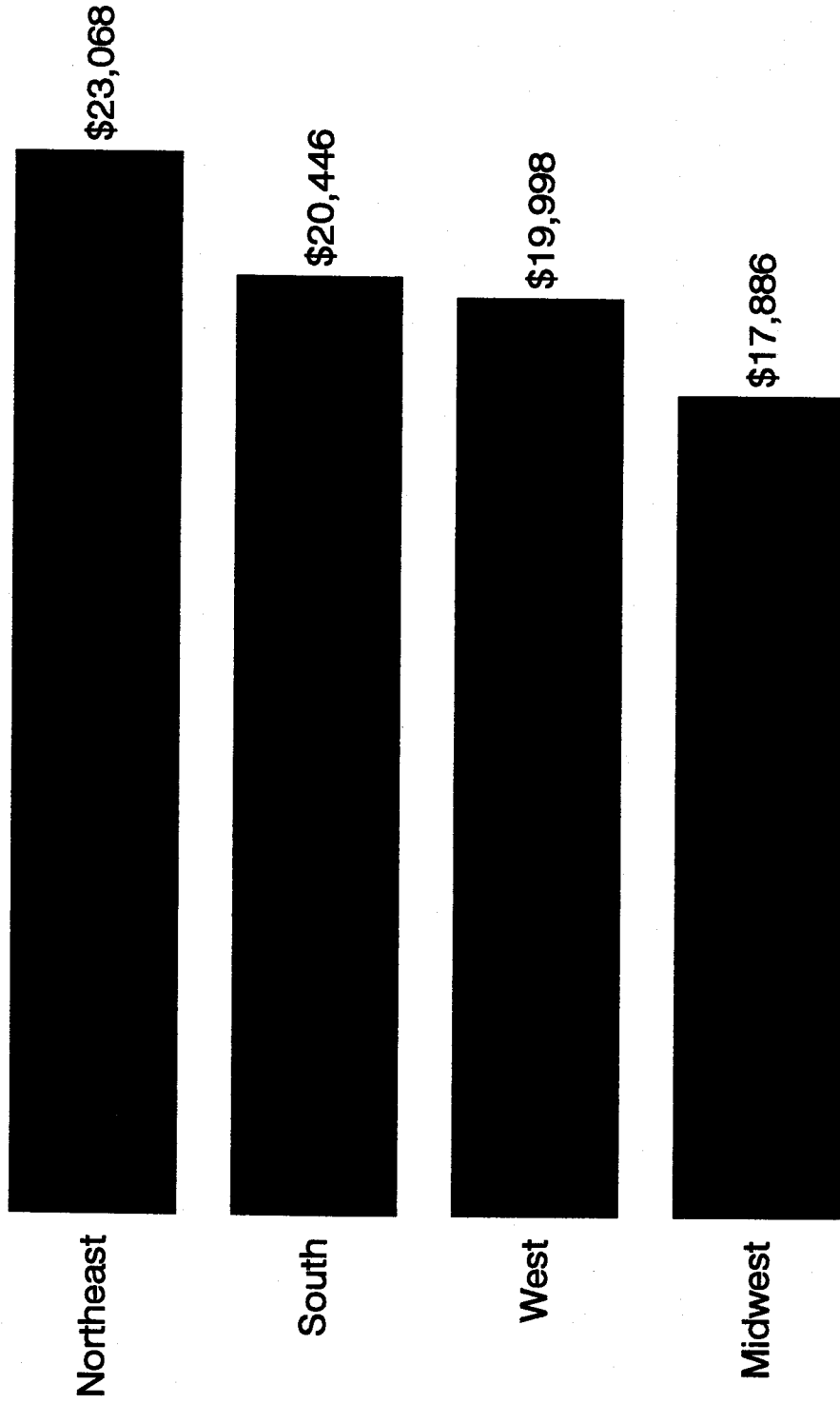
Percent of Unemployed American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut Females: 1990

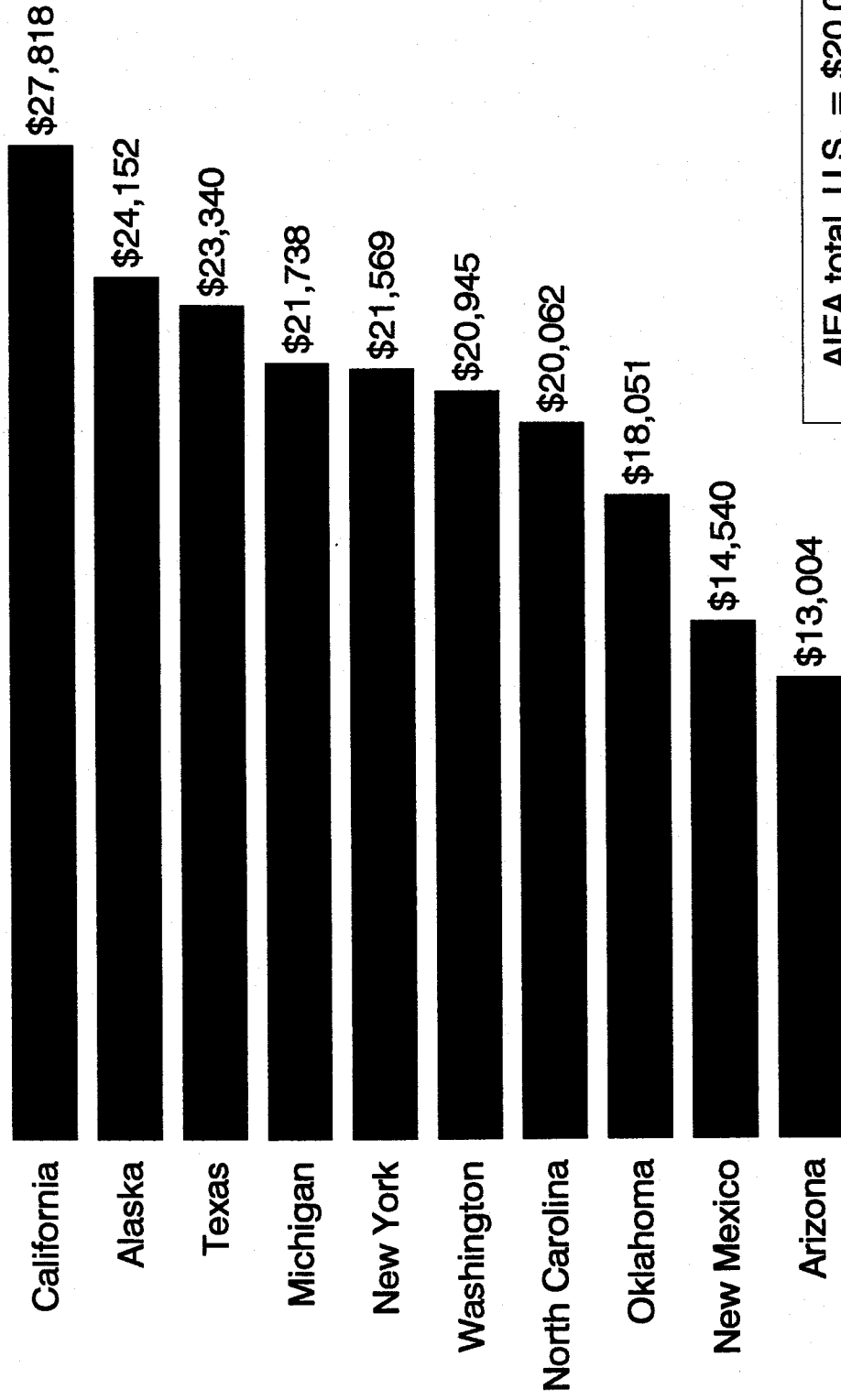

Median Household Income in 1989 of American Indians, Eskimos, and Aleuts: 1990



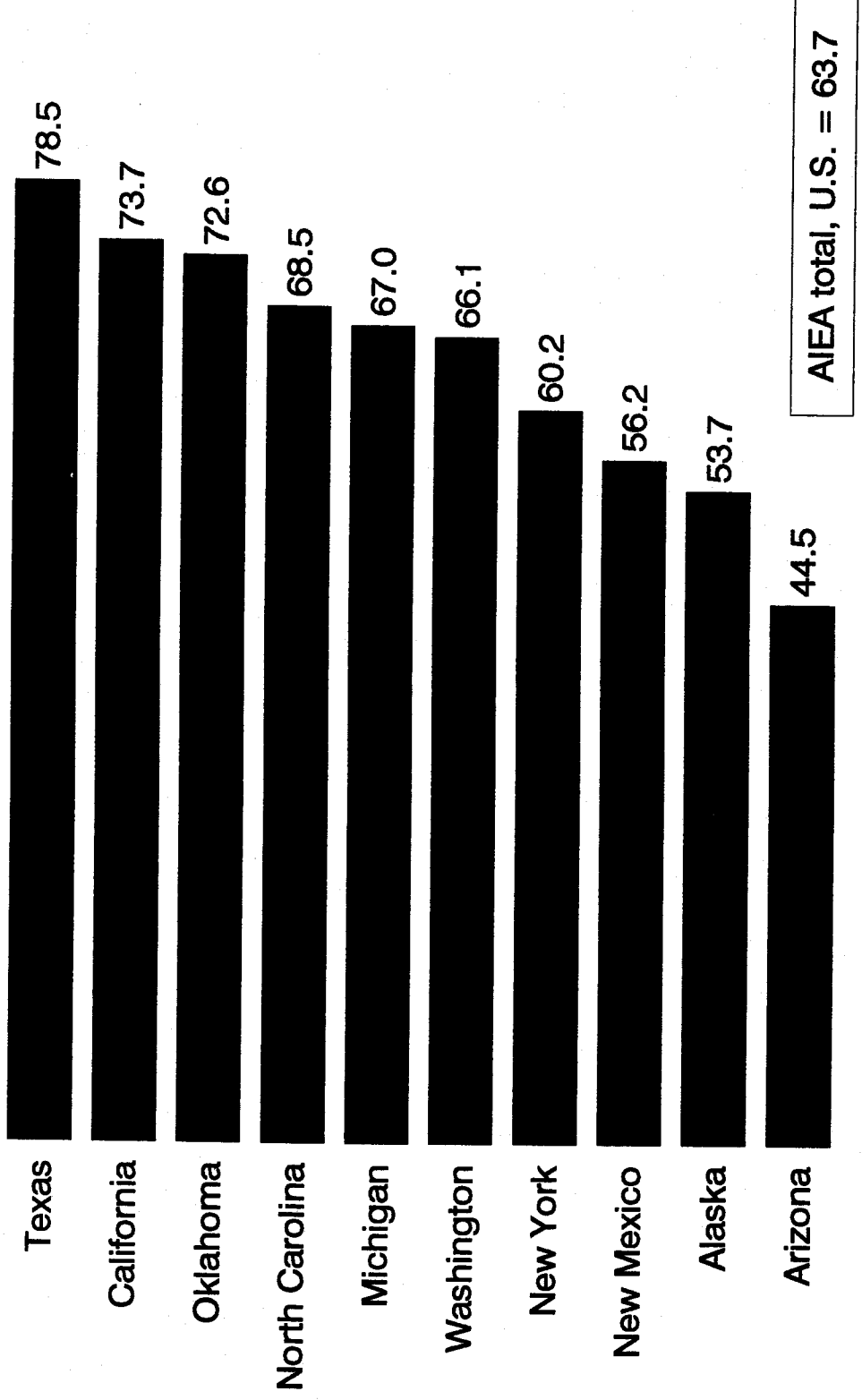

Median Household Income in 1989 of American Indians, Eskimos, and Aleuts: 1990

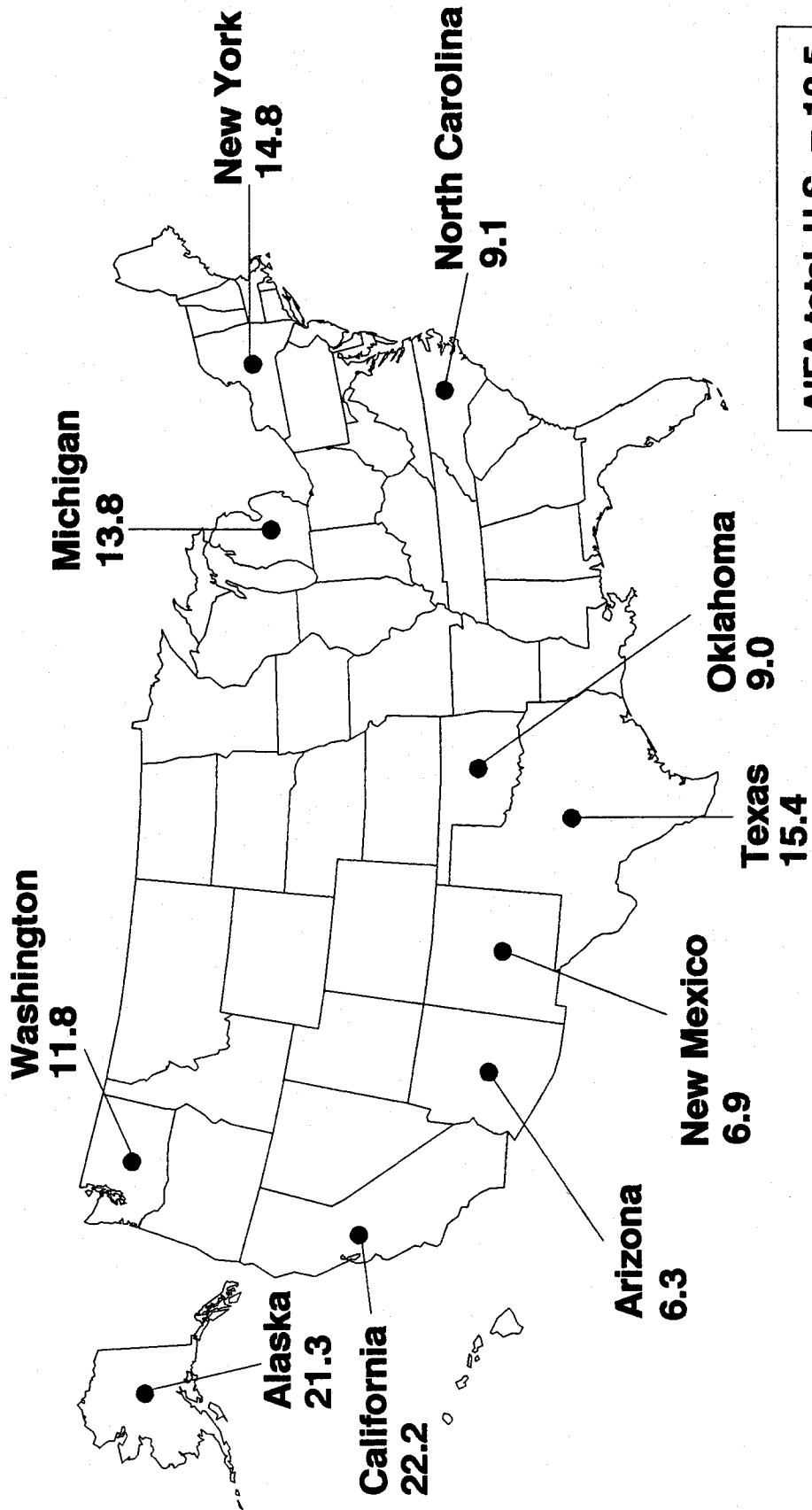

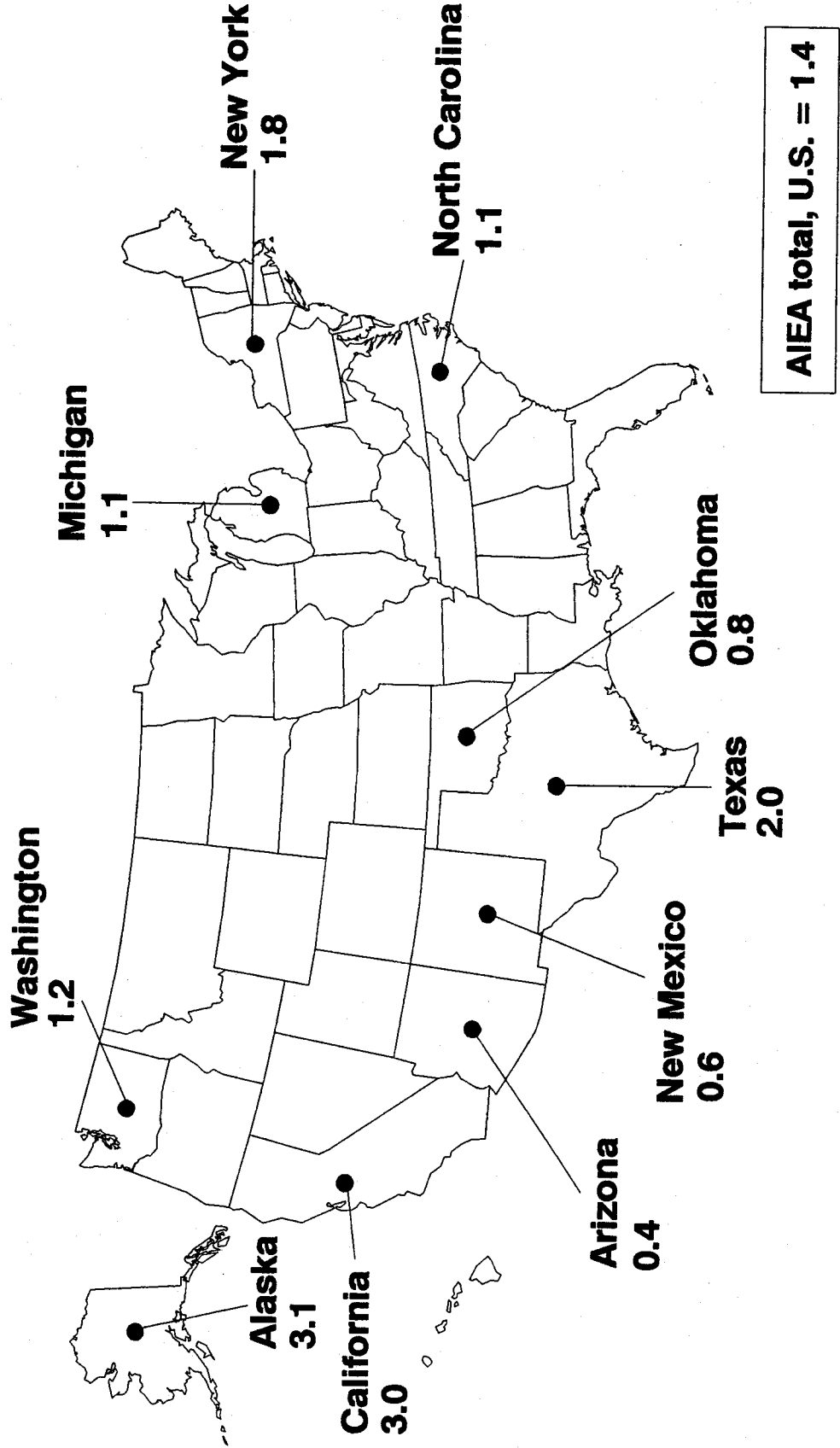
Median Household Income Ratio in 1989 of American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut to White: 1990



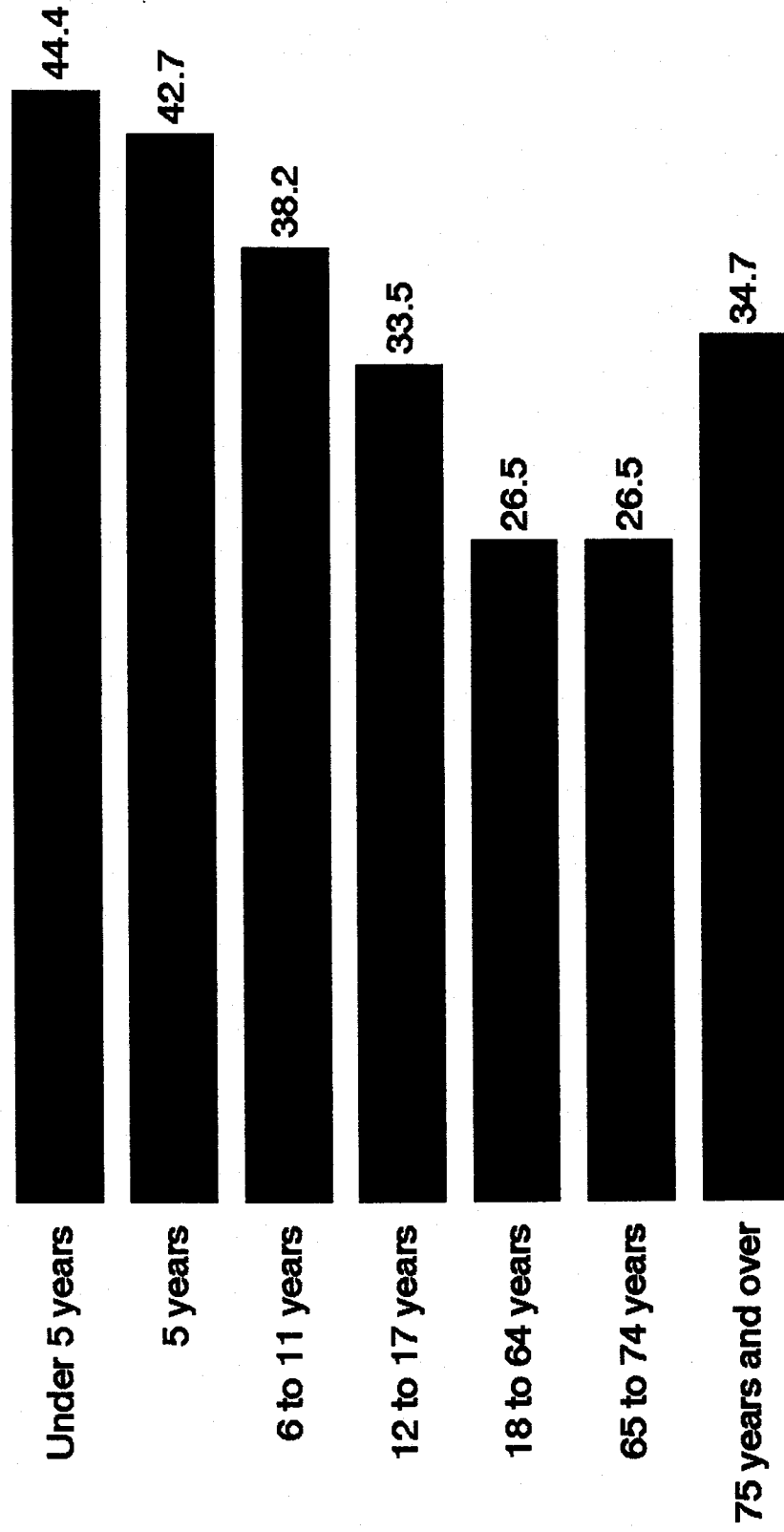
Percent of American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut Households With Incomes in 1989 of \$50,000 or More: 1990



Percent of American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut Households With Incomes in 1989 of \$100,000 or More: 1990

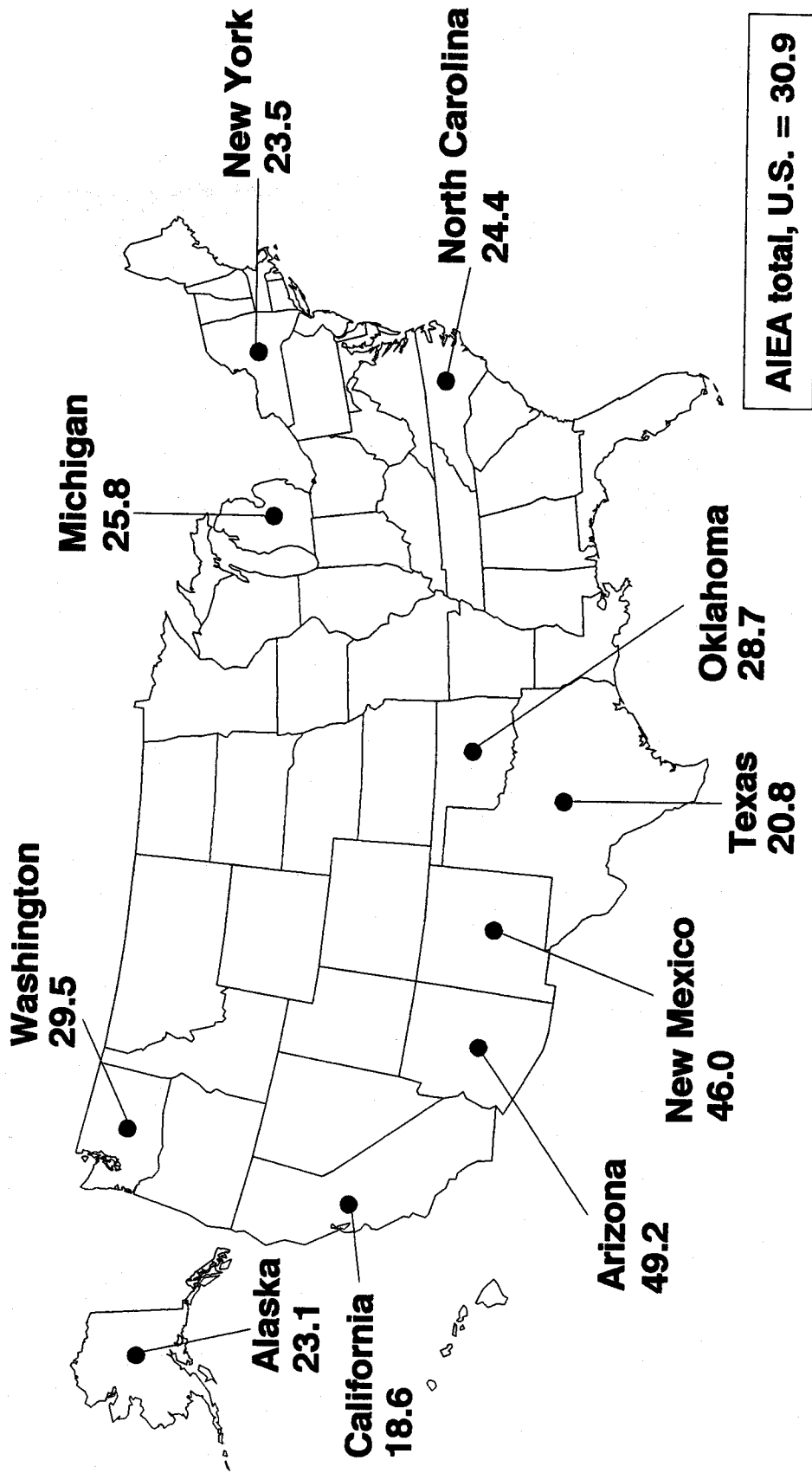

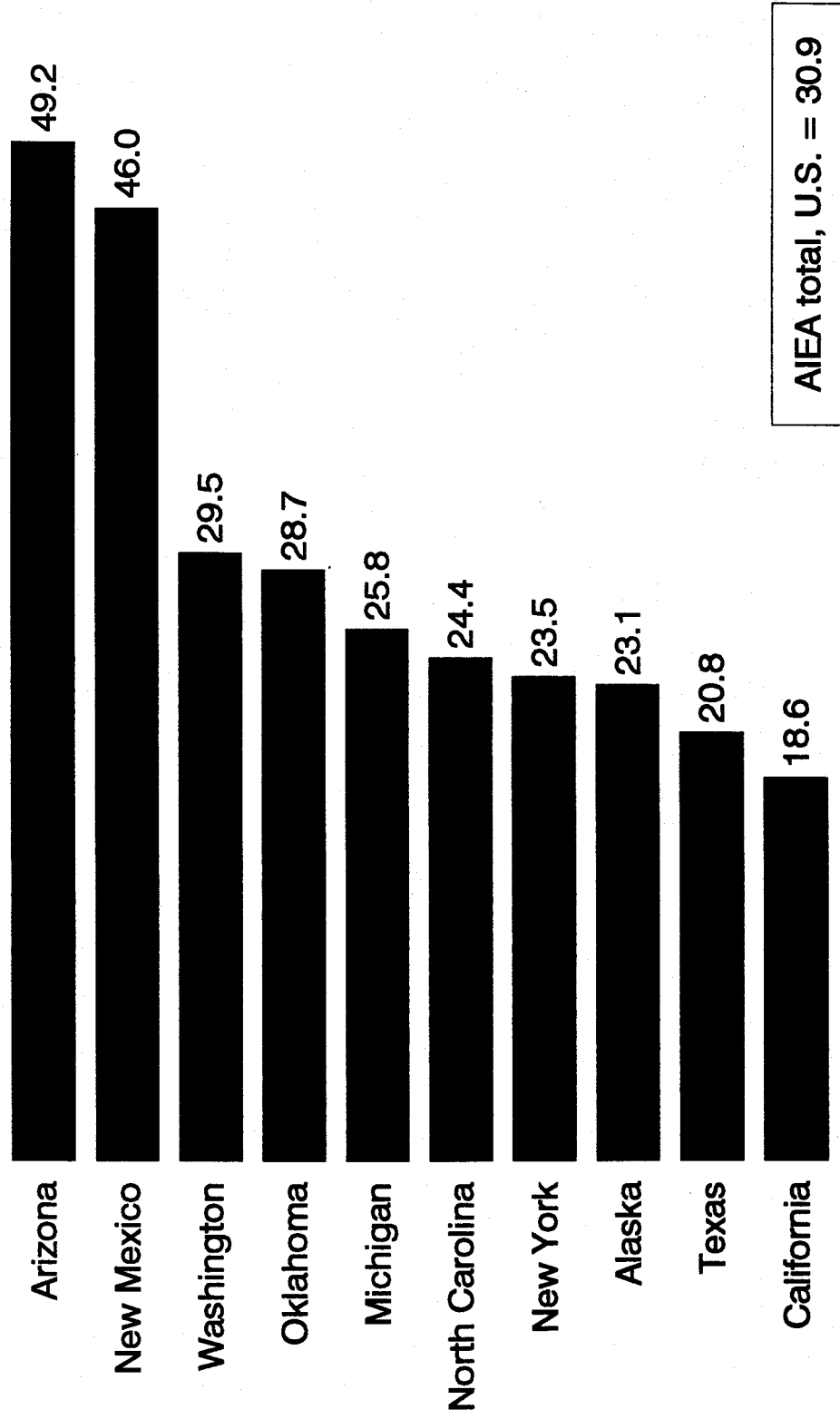

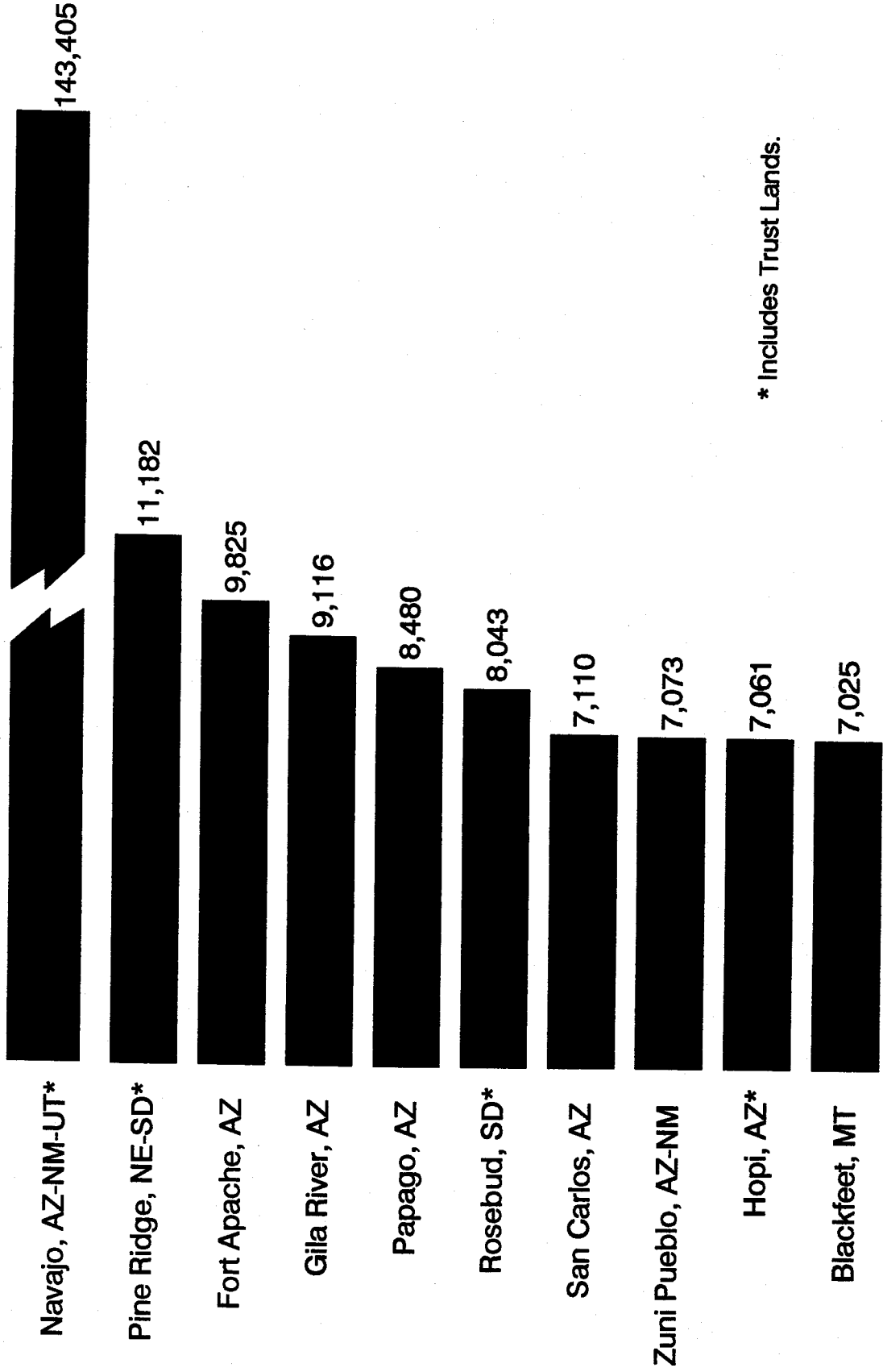

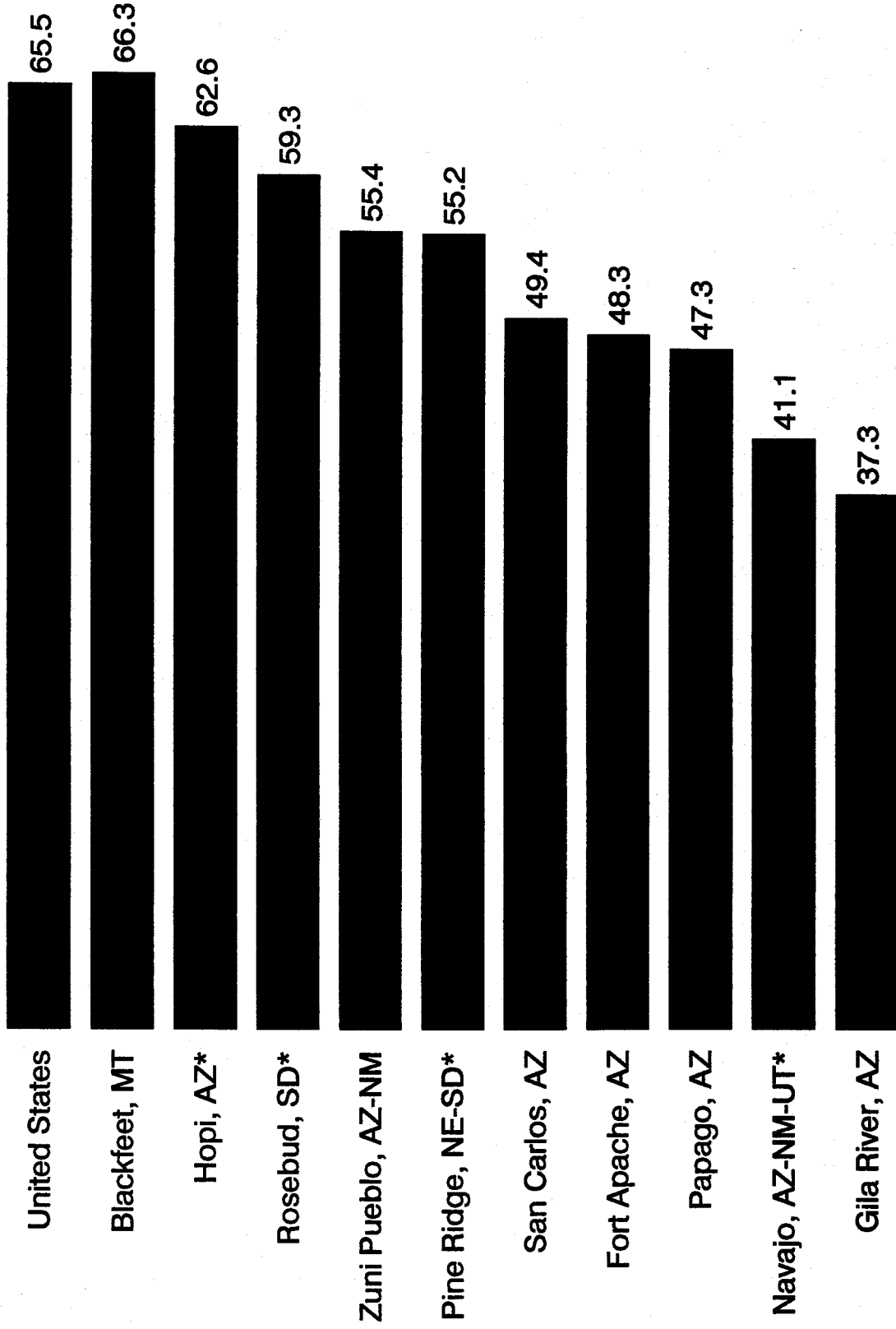
Ten Reservations With the Largest American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut Population: 1990

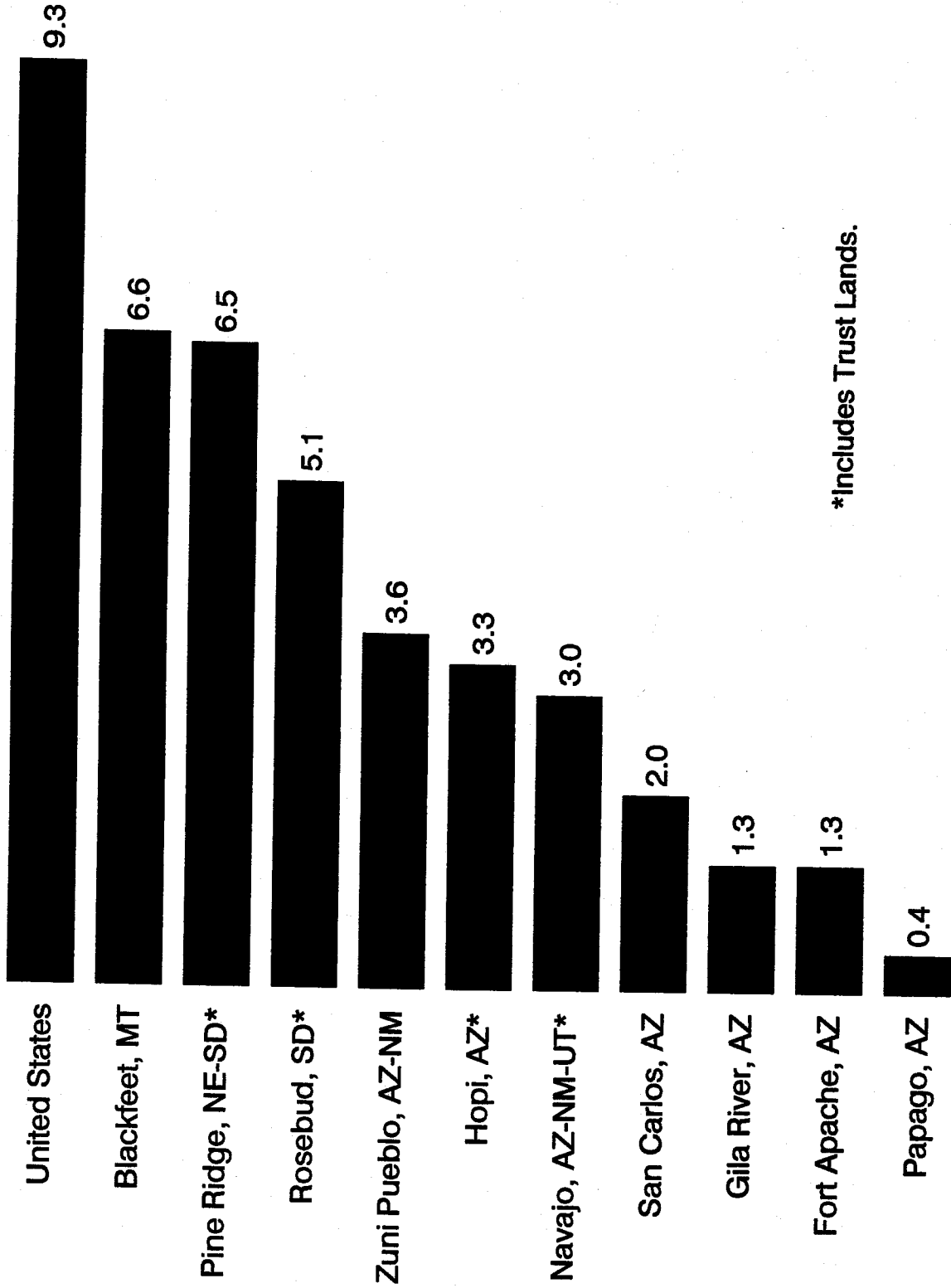
Percent American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut High School Graduates, for Selected Reservations: 1990

(Persons 25 years old and over)



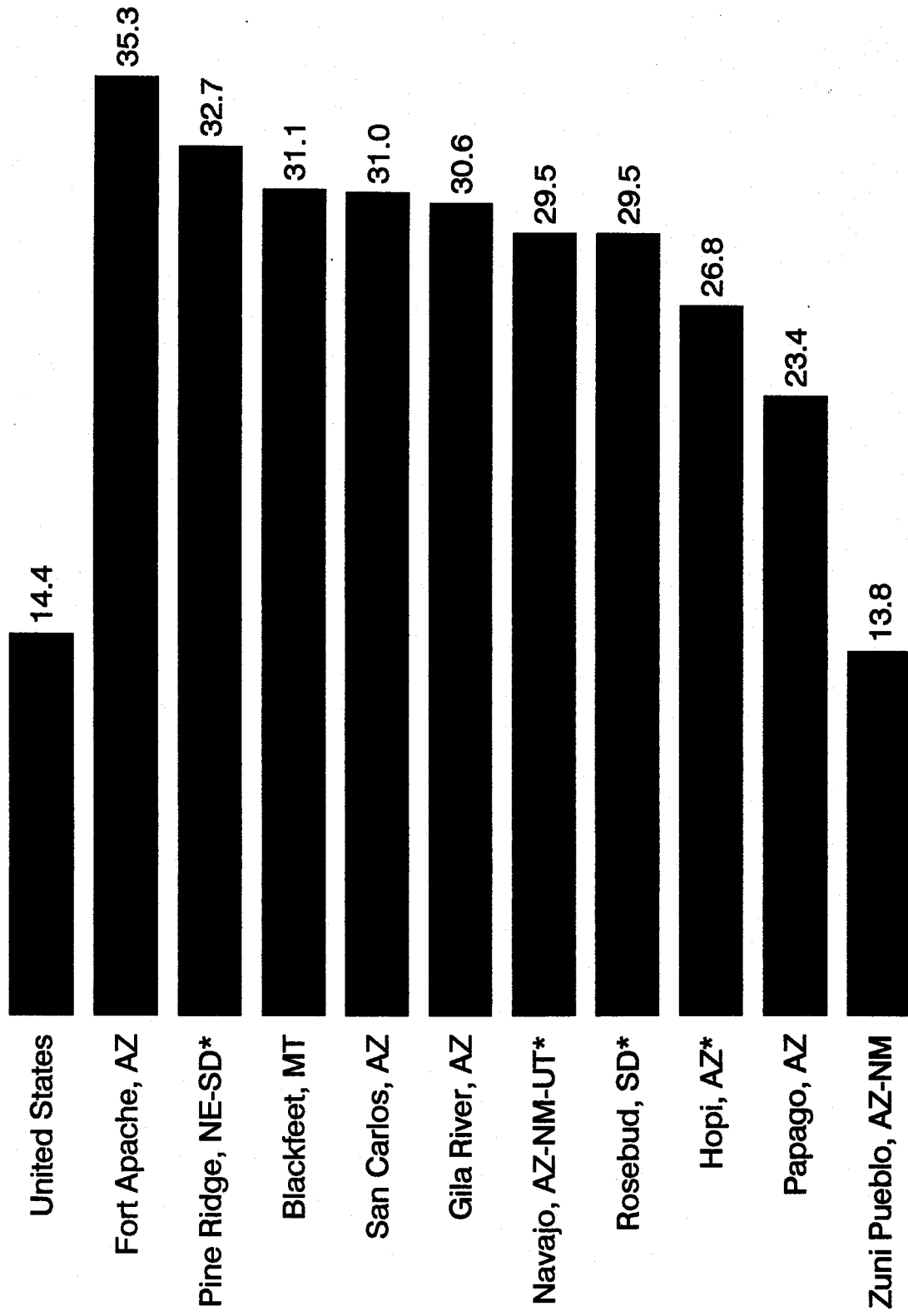

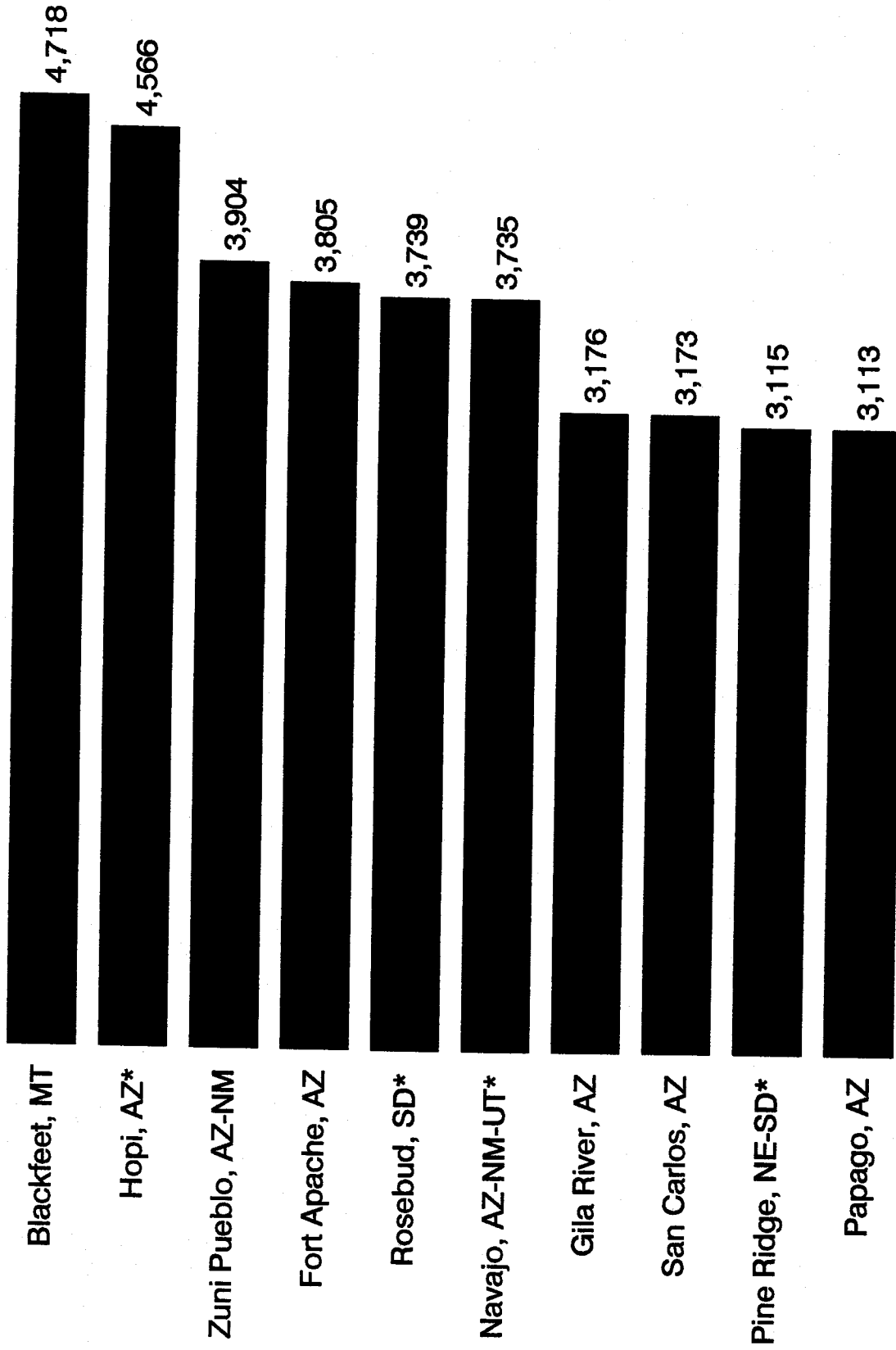

Percent American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut Population Unemployed for Selected Reservations: 1990 (Civilian persons 16 years and over)



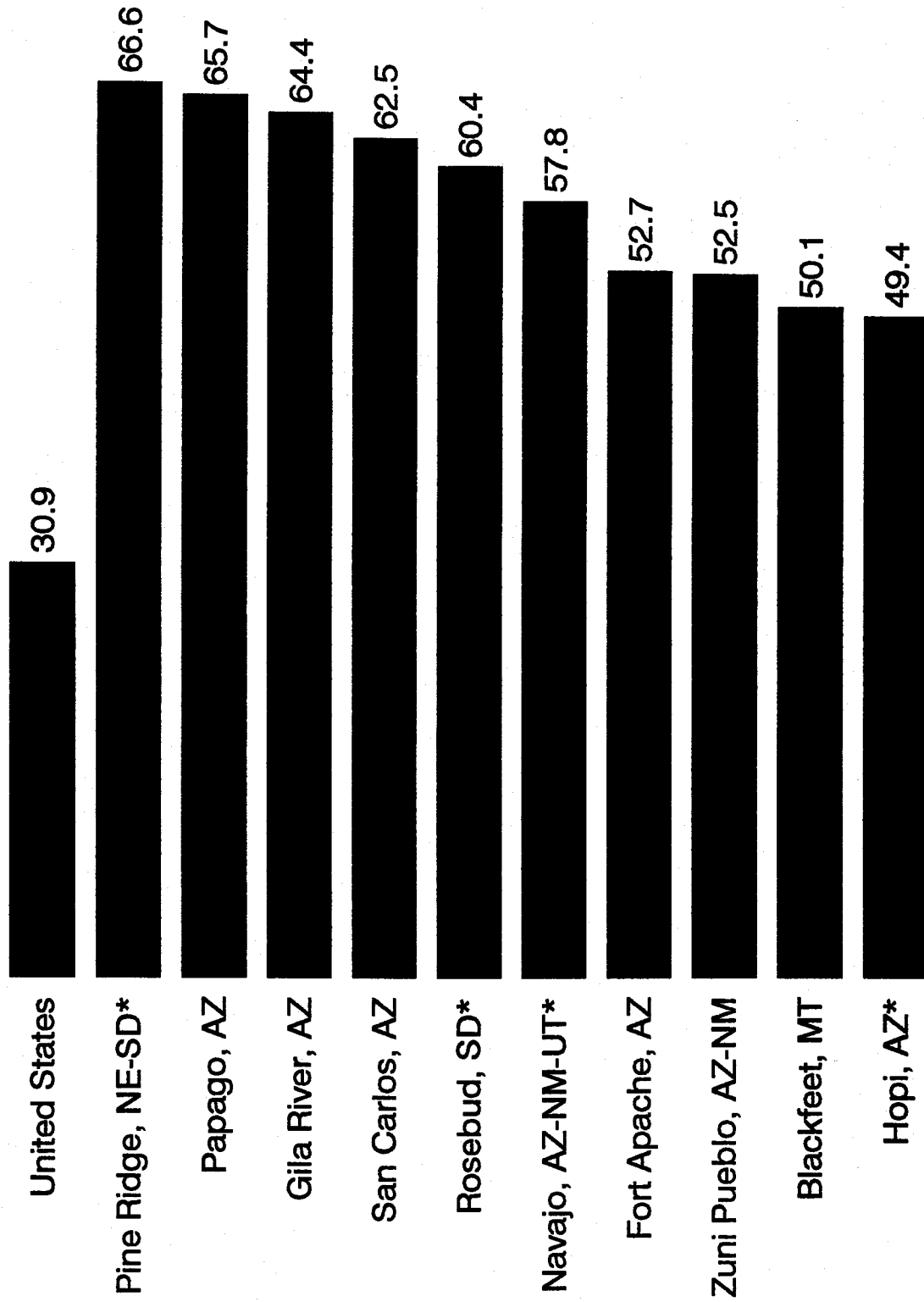

Per Capita Income in 1989 for the American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut Population for Selected Reservations: 1990 (Dollars)



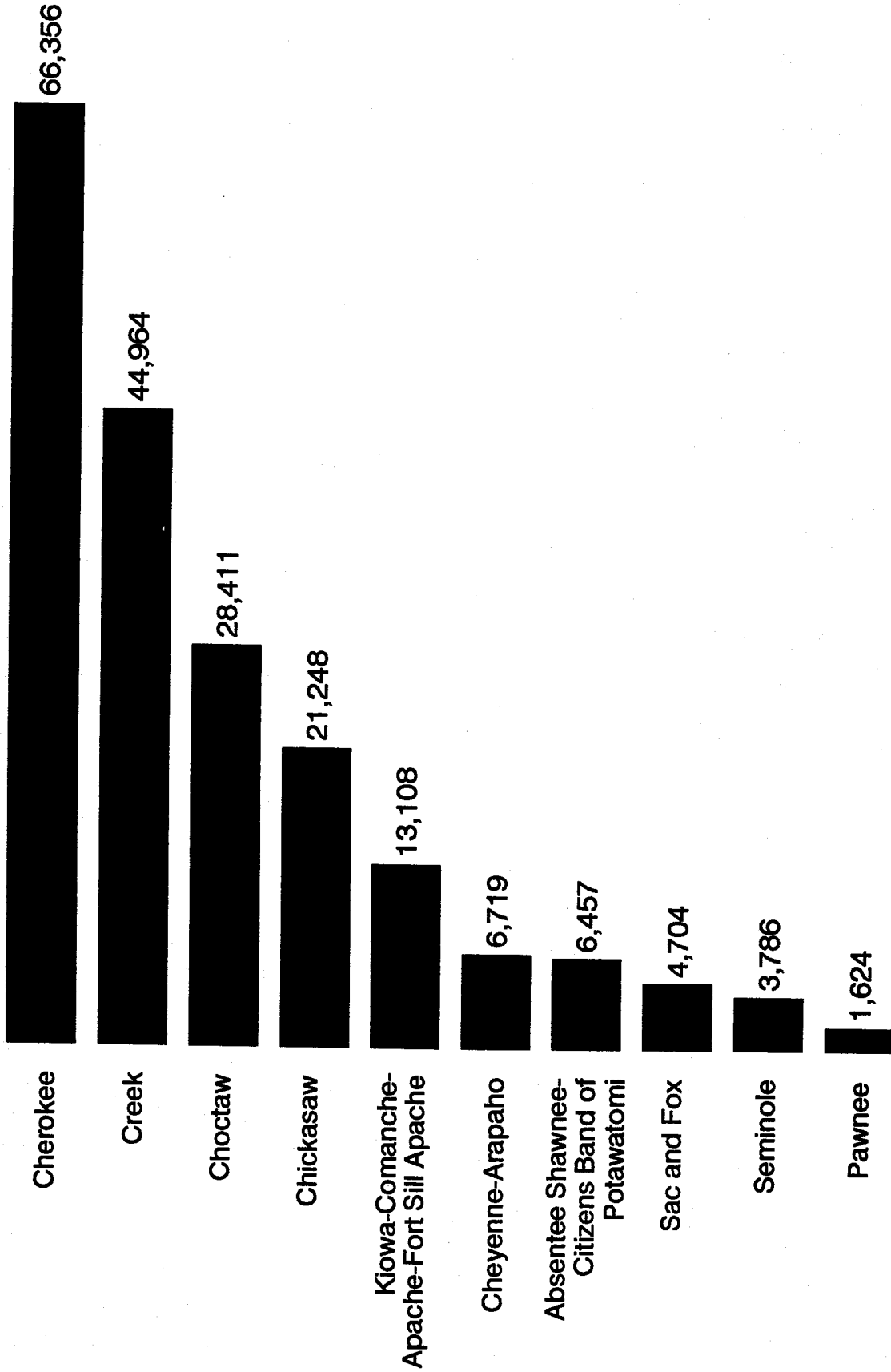

Poverty Rates in 1989 for American Indians, Eskimos, and Aleuts for Selected Reservations: 1990



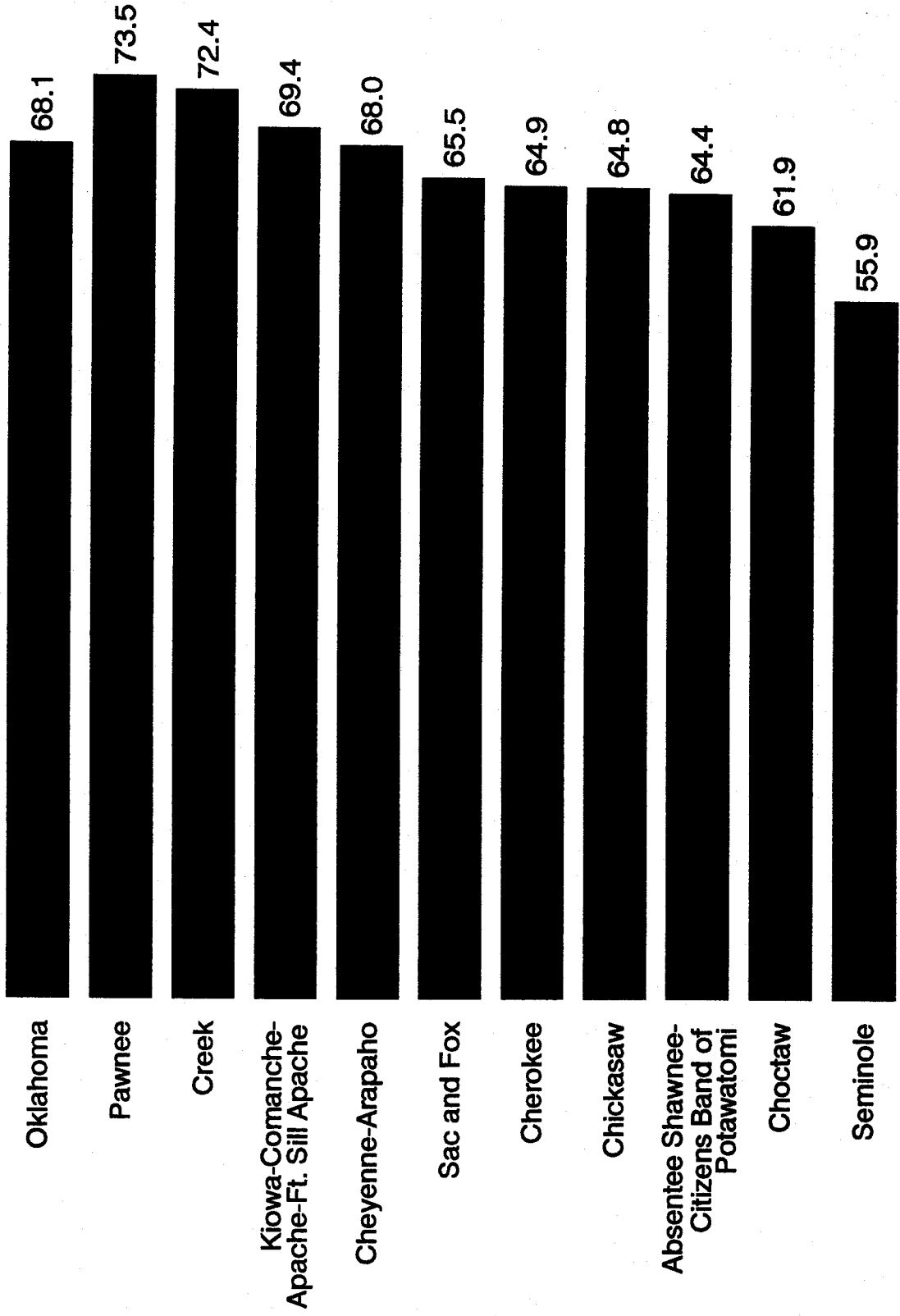

Ten Tribal Jurisdiction Statistical Areas With the Largest American Indian, Eskimo, or Aleut Population: 1990

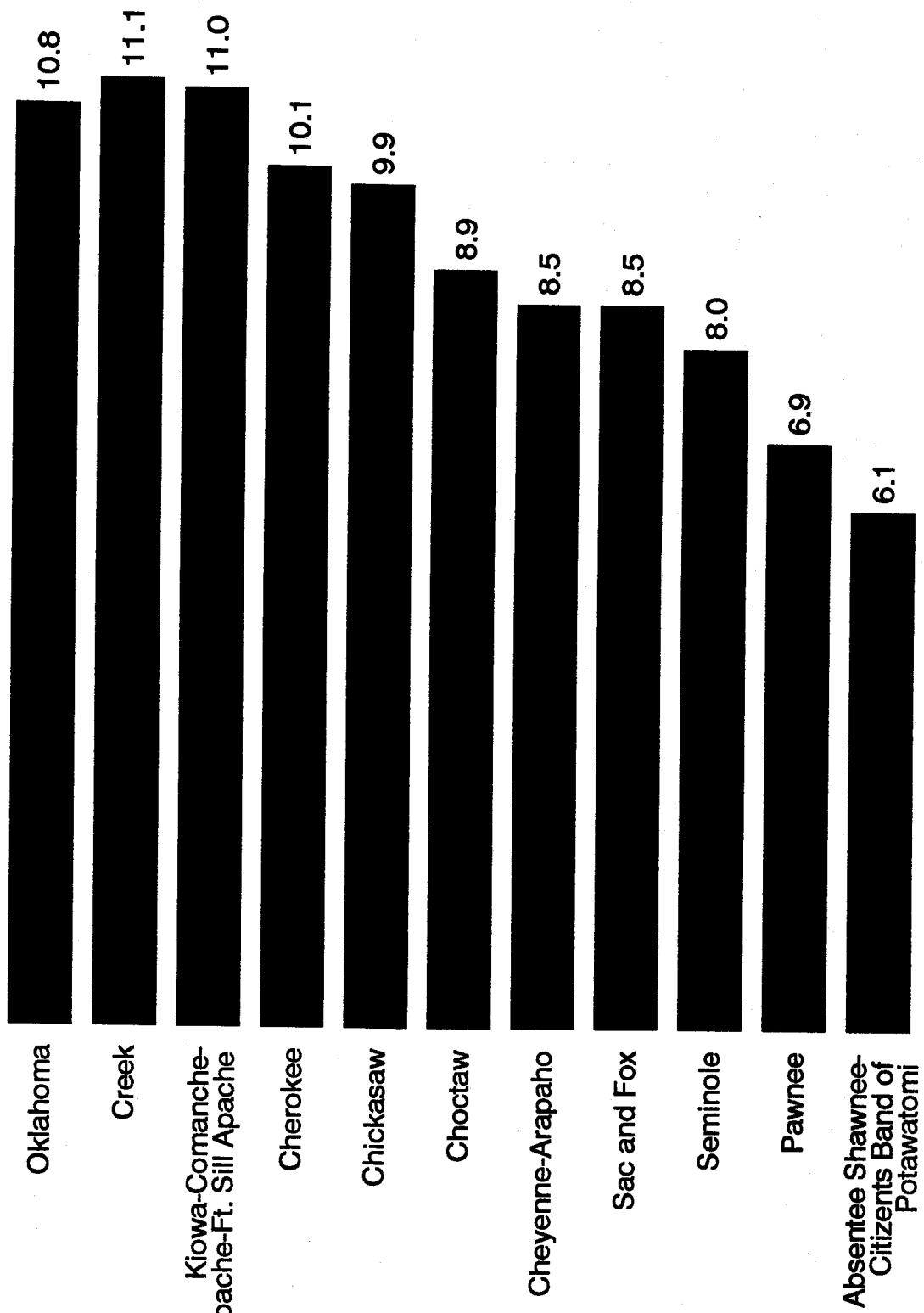


Percent American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut High School Graduates for Selected Tribal Jurisdiction Statistical Areas: 1990

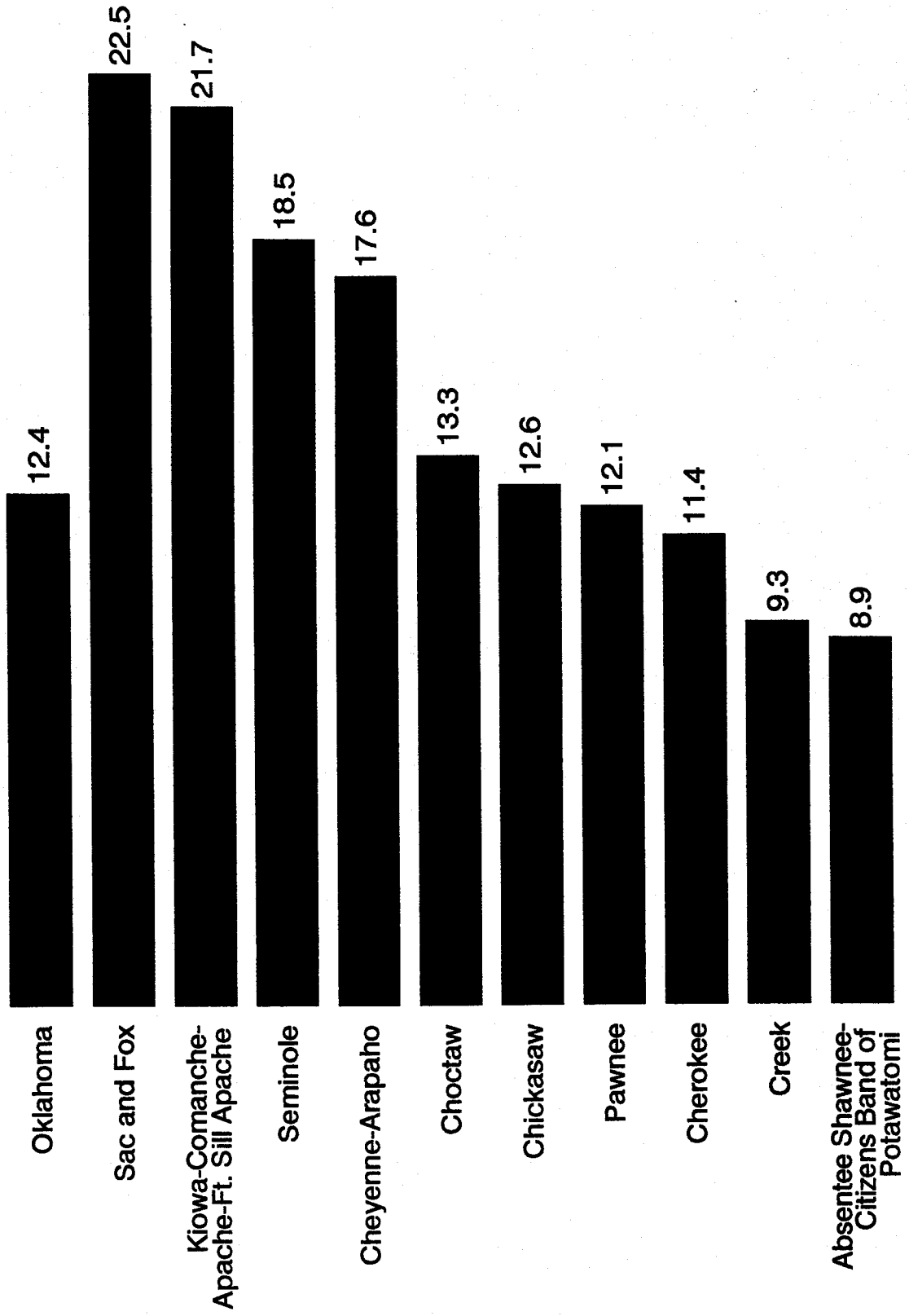

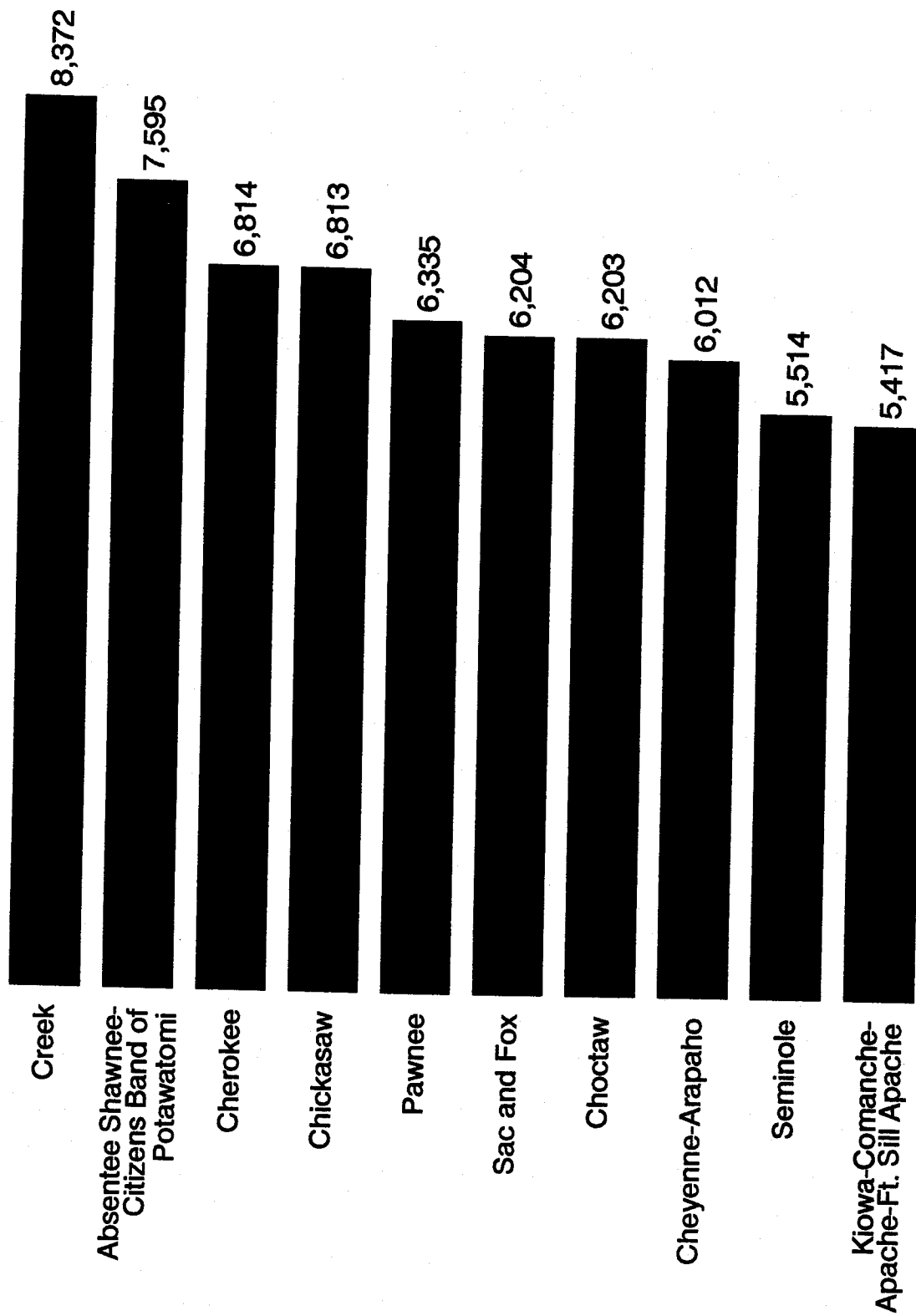

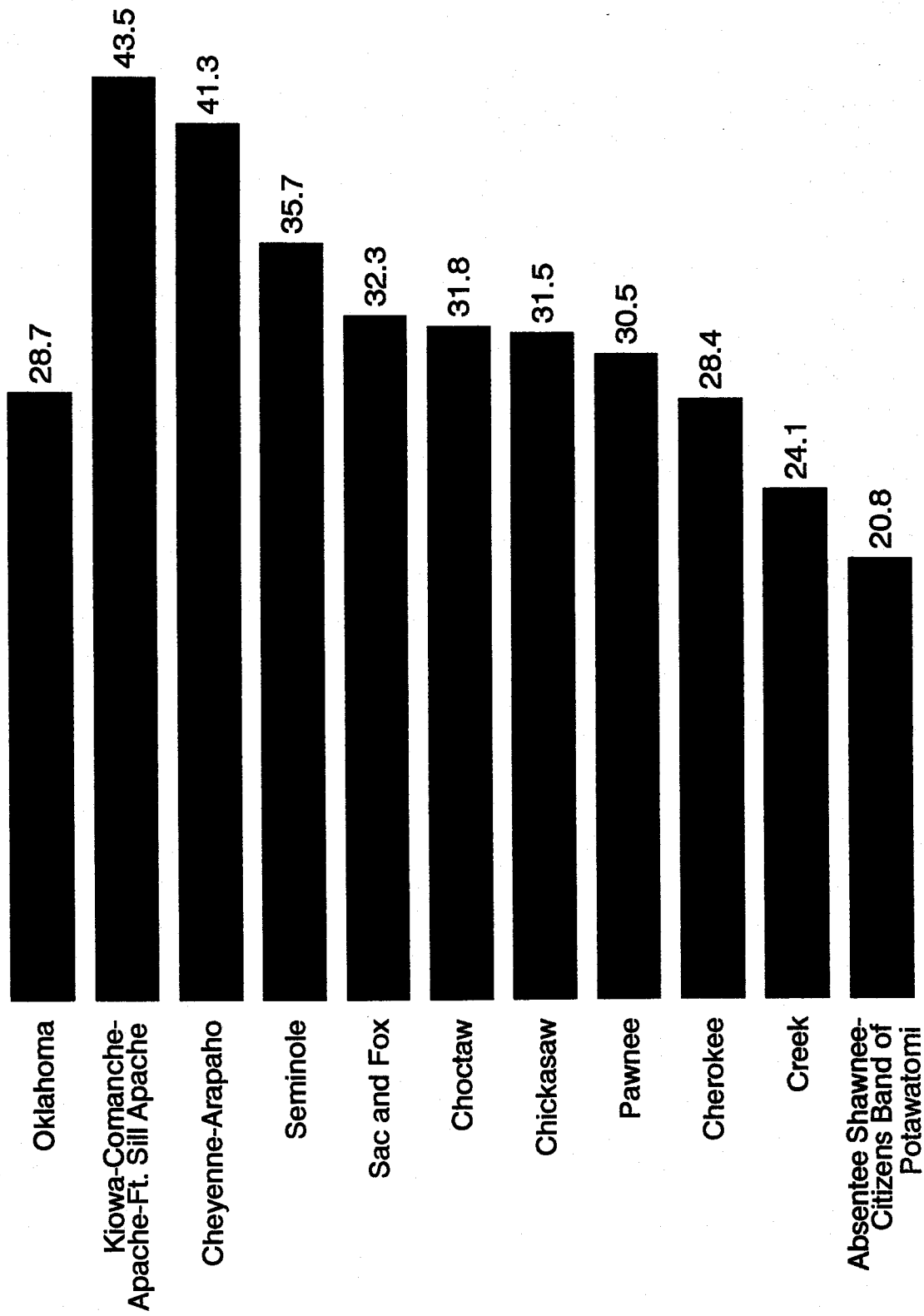

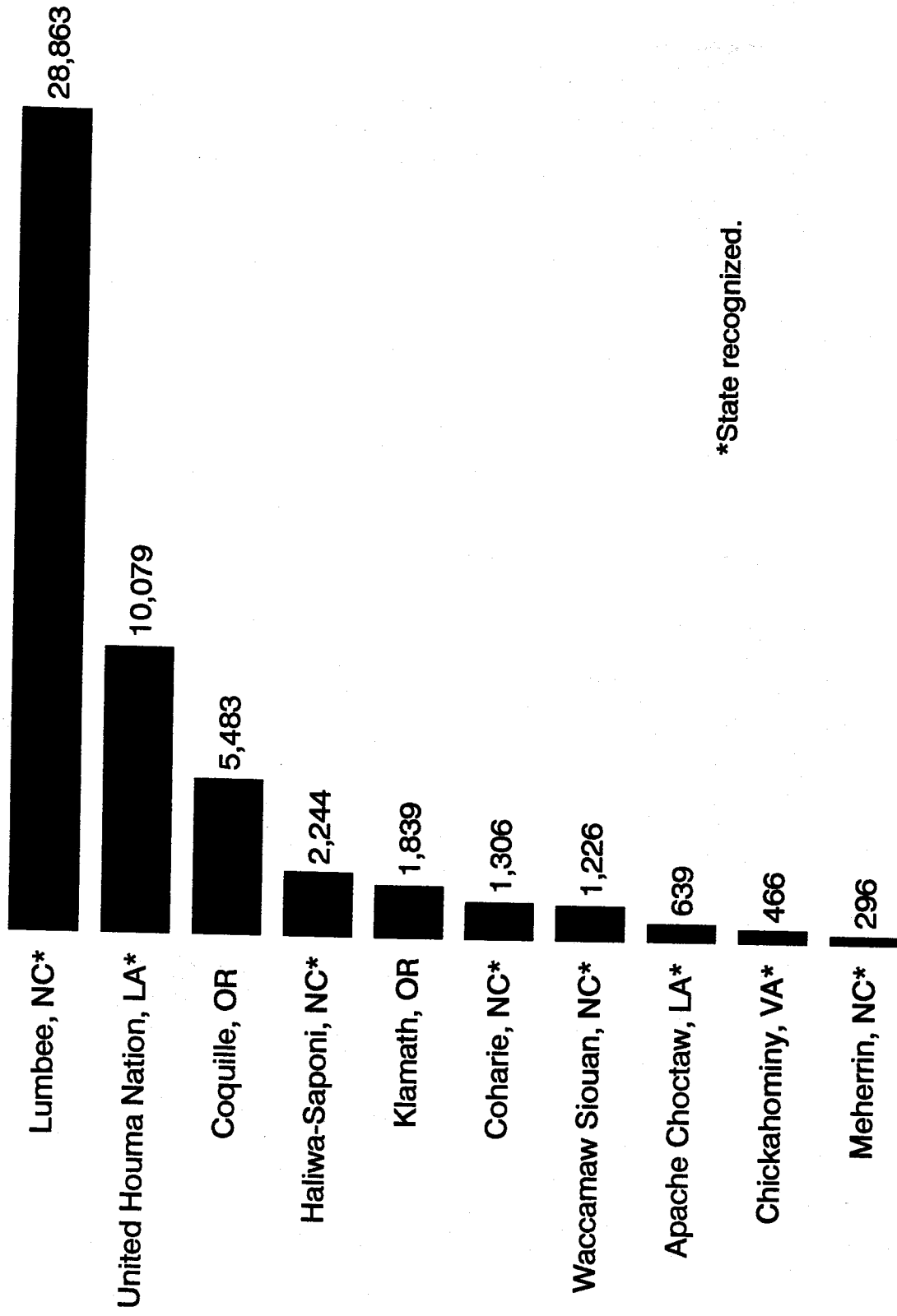

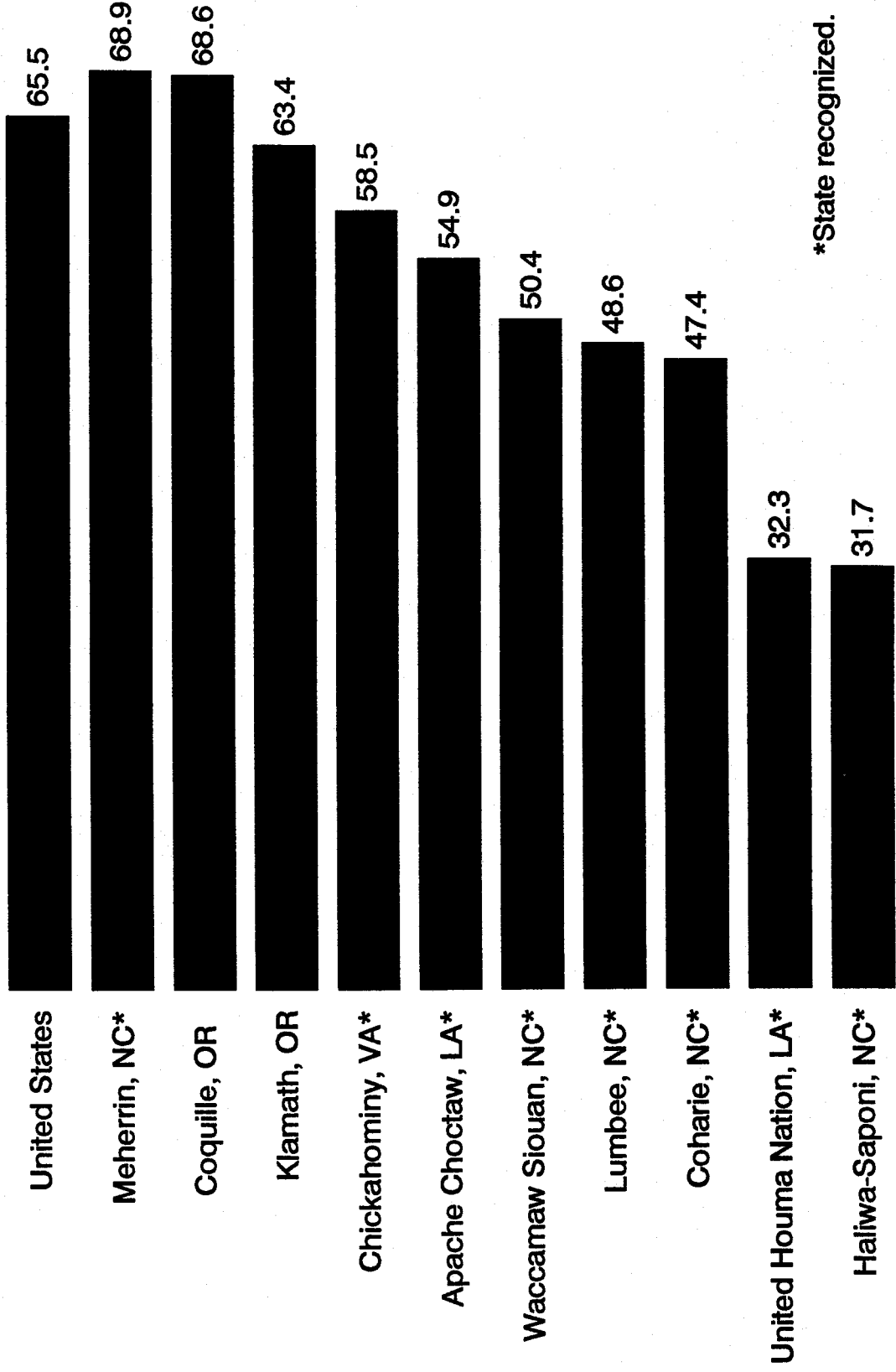


Ten Tribal Designated Statistical Areas With the Largest American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut Population: 1990



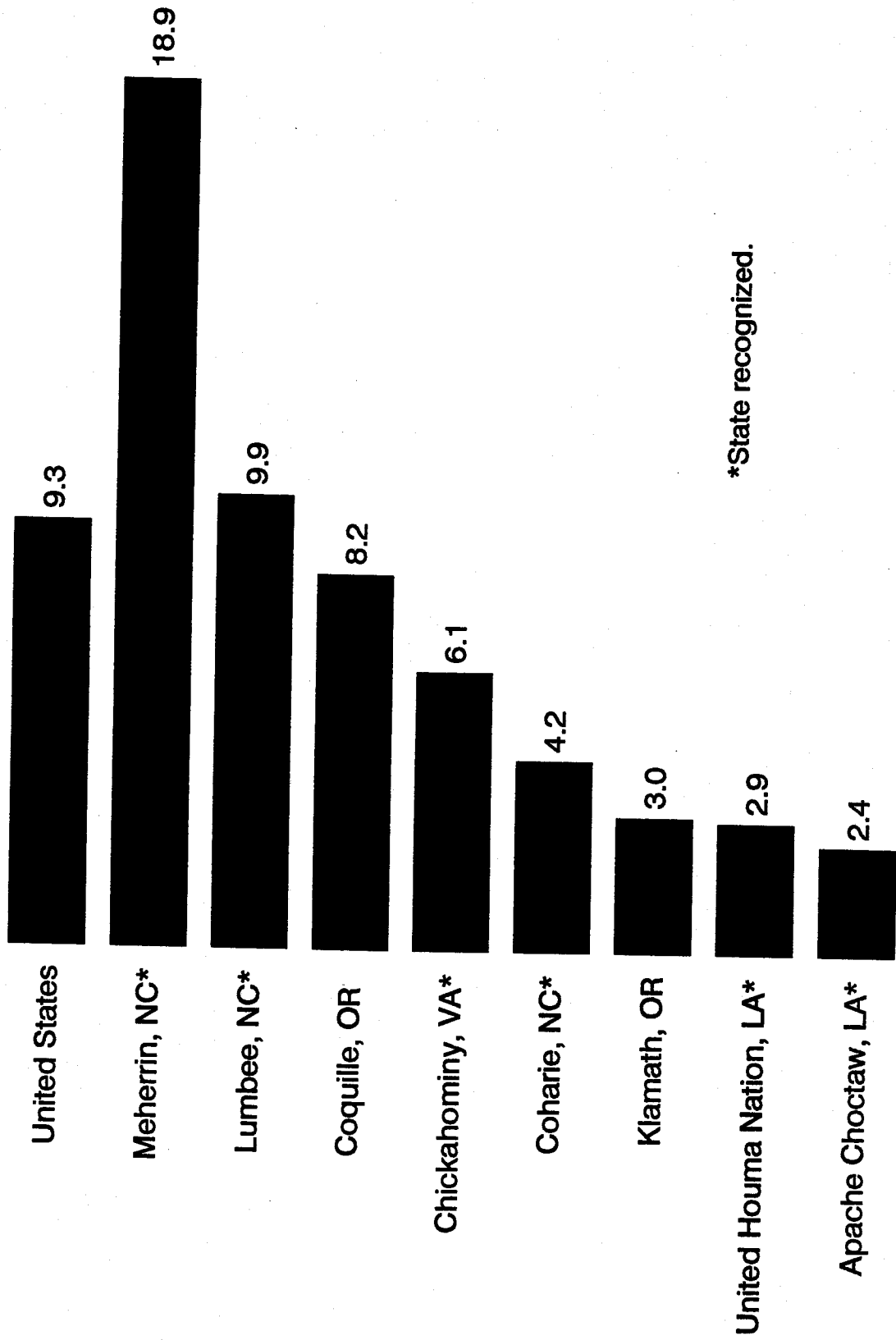

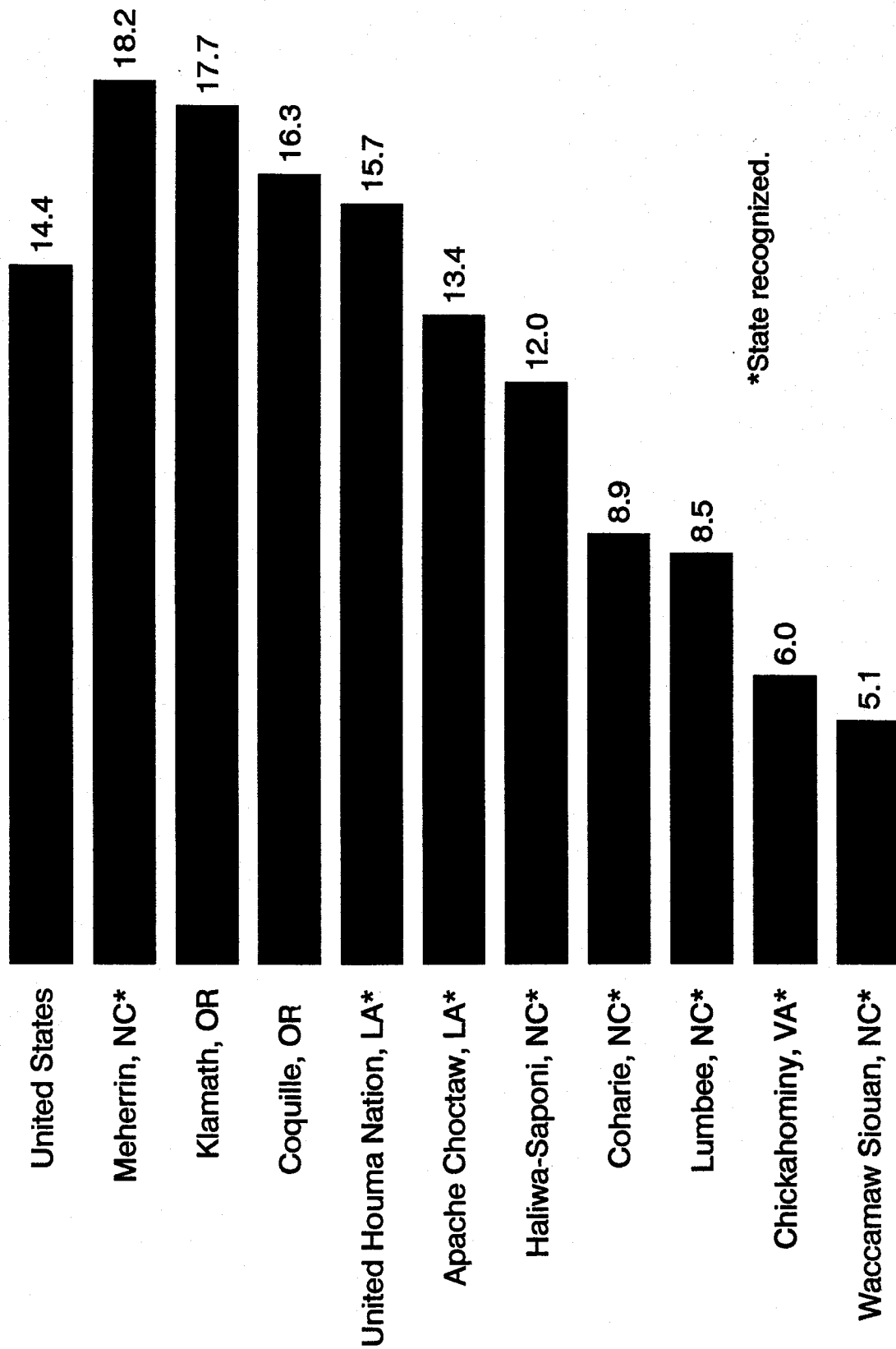

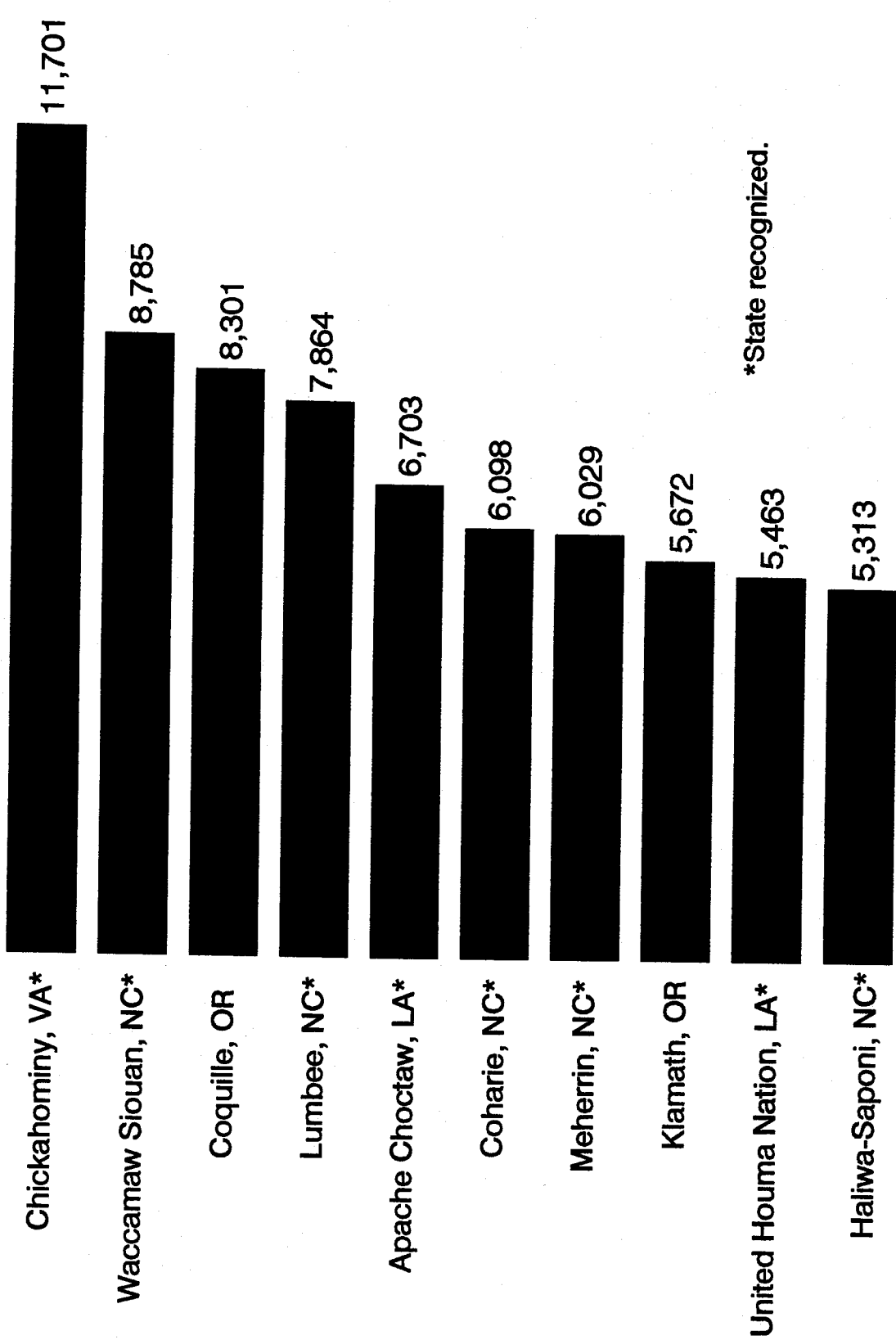

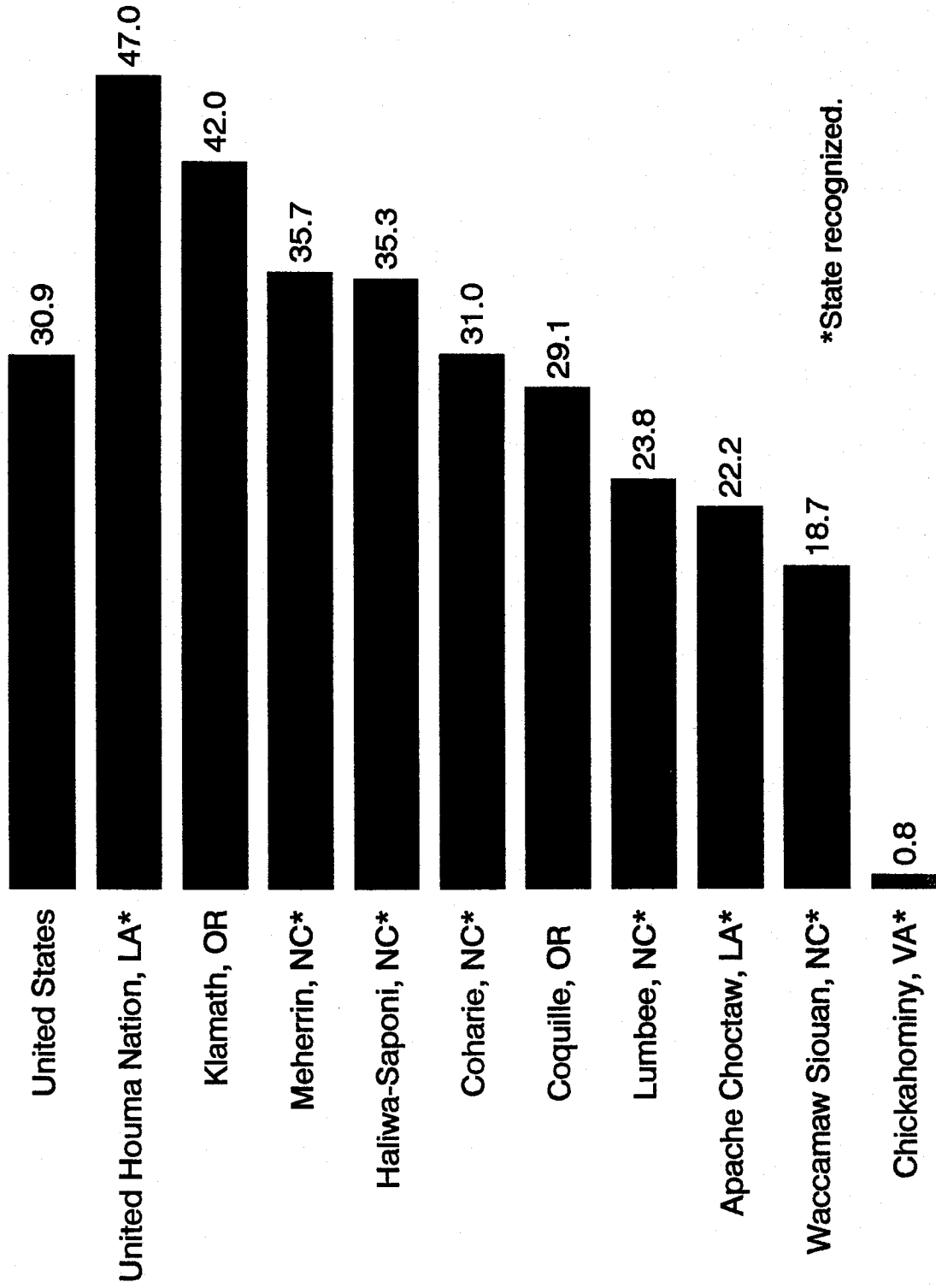

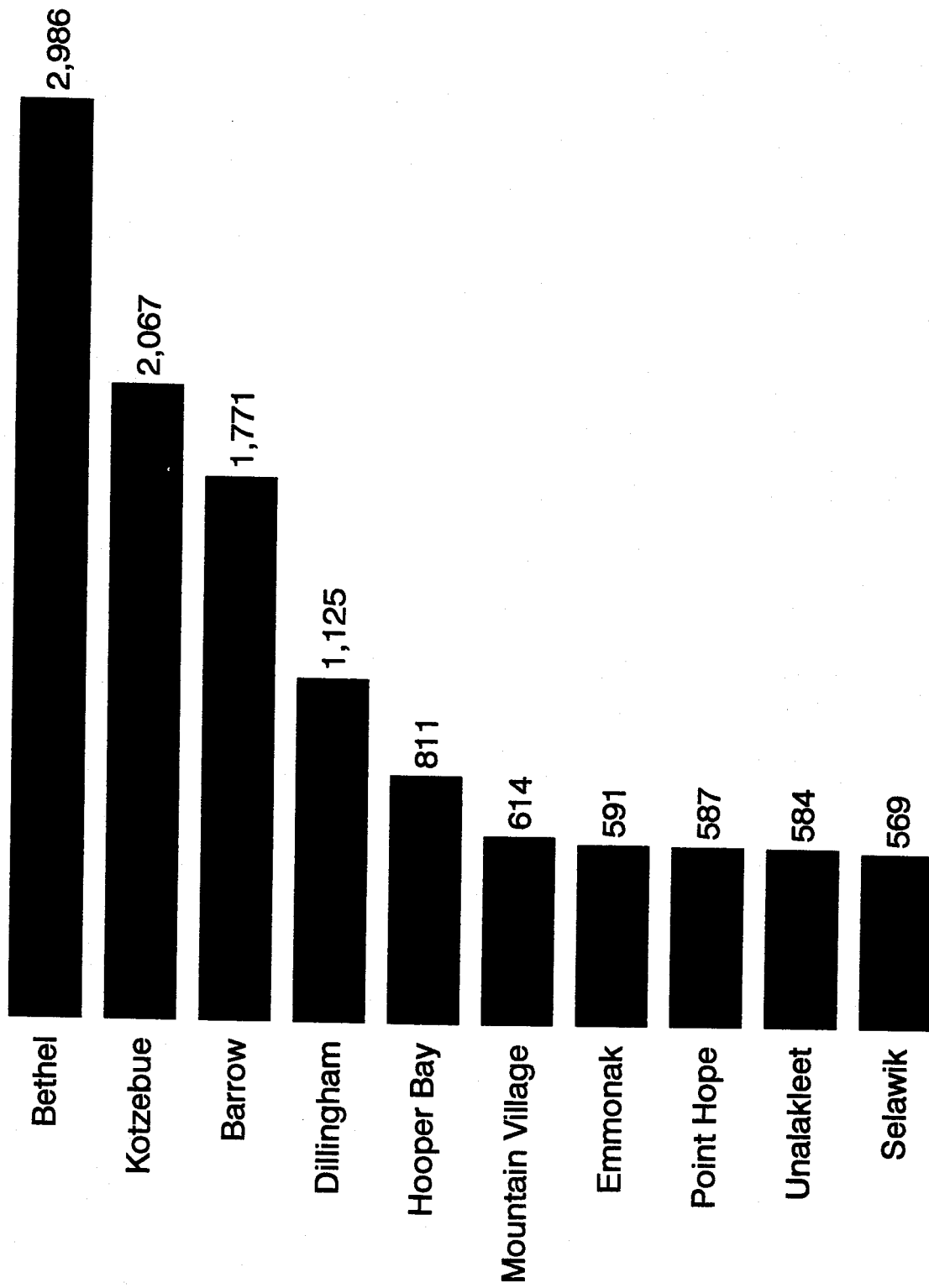

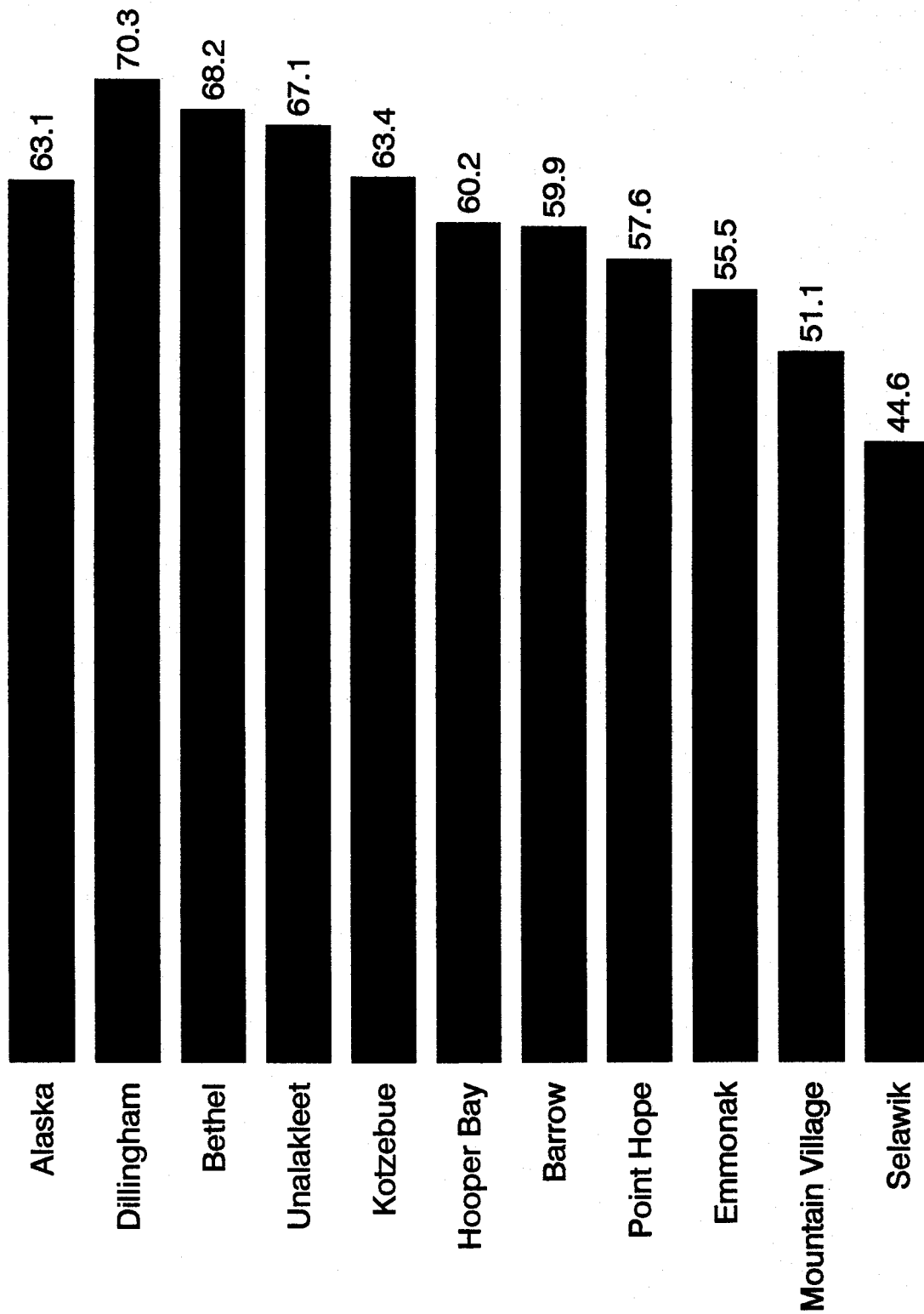
