

### Appendix 3: Detailed Tables

The 1991 Household Income and Expenditures Survey (HIES) of the Republic of Palau used two methods to collect data on the income and expenditures of Palau residents: questionnaires, either administered by enumerators or left with households to complete on their own; and Daily Expenditures Diaries, left with households to complete over two successive weeks during the survey period. The 587 households that answered questionnaires, and the 304 households that also participated in the diary phase of the HIES, provided valuable information on the types, sources, and amounts of income flowing into Palau households as well as the expenditure patterns of these households.

*The report* presents questionnaire and diary data, along with analyses of these data and narratives. But the survey collected much data which the report does not contain due to constraints of space. Given the potential insights contained in the survey data on a range of issues important both to understanding current income and expenditure patterns and to planning Palau's future, senior HIES personnel felt that a more complete presentation of data was in order. This appendix presents these detailed data.

This first section contains tabular summaries of data obtained during the questionnaire phase of the HIES. These tables summarize all questionnaire data collected in the survey. Tables in this section are designated with alpha-numeric labels, each beginning with a *Q* -- serving to identify a questionnaire table and distinguish such a table from any constructed with data from Daily Expenditures Diaries (presented in the second part of the appendix). Through the use of the following tables, one can conduct analyses in addition to those presented in the report.

The following pages contain three different groups of questionnaire tables. The first group, comprising Table Q.1 through Table Q.18, presents questionnaire data cross-tabulated by age of respondent. Table Q.19 through Table Q.37 present questionnaire data cross-tabulated by state in Palau. Finally, Tables Q.38, Q.39, and Q.40 present questionnaire data on major expenditures, regular expenditures, and earnings from home-produced items, respectively, cross-tabulated by urban and rural residence. As in the report, *urban* households comprise all households located in Airai and Koror states, while *rural* households are those located in the remaining states.

## Diary Data Tables

Tables in this section are designated with alpha-numeric labels, each beginning with a *D* -- serving to identify a diary table and distinguish such a table from any constructed with data from the questionnaire portion of the survey. Through the use of the following tables, one can conduct analyses in addition to those presented in Volume 1 of this report.

Each table constructed with Daily Expenditures Diary data describes a major category of expenditure -- such as "Meat and Fish" products described in Table D.1. Similarly, each presents expenditures data for all households, urban households, and rural households -- allowing comparisons between these categories of residence. As in Volume 1, *urban* households refer to all households located in Airai and Koror states, while *rural* households refer to those located outside these two states.
